



Sunday Night Nursery Ministers Needed!

We are currently recruiting a team of nursery ministers to provide care for children ages 0-3 during adult religious education classes on Sundays from 5:30-7pm. Classes begin Sunday, September 15 and run through May 3.

Spotting the Serpent CMG – Safe Haven Training

The story of the creation of man in the book of Genesis presents the setting of the Garden of Eden. In this garden, Adam and Eve and other creatures lived in harmony. However, even in this paradise, they could abuse their free will. It took a talking serpent to entice them into his trap.

From time to time, the Catholic Church must protect herself from serpents trying to lead others to sin and to cause harm to others. The liturgy on earth is also vulnerable from such attacks. The only perfect liturgy is in Heaven, adoring in the face of God. For now, we must be on guard to the many threats that may come...sin, temptation and those that would harm children. Hopefully, you will ask: how?

Formerly known as VIRTUS, CMG Safe Haven is an upgraded safe environment program and it is online for all volunteers to be trained. The Archdiocese has made it mandatory for all parish volunteers (<u>including liturgical ministries</u>) to complete the training. This way, the volunteers are armed with the necessary awareness on how to spot the serpents among us and prevent abuse.


