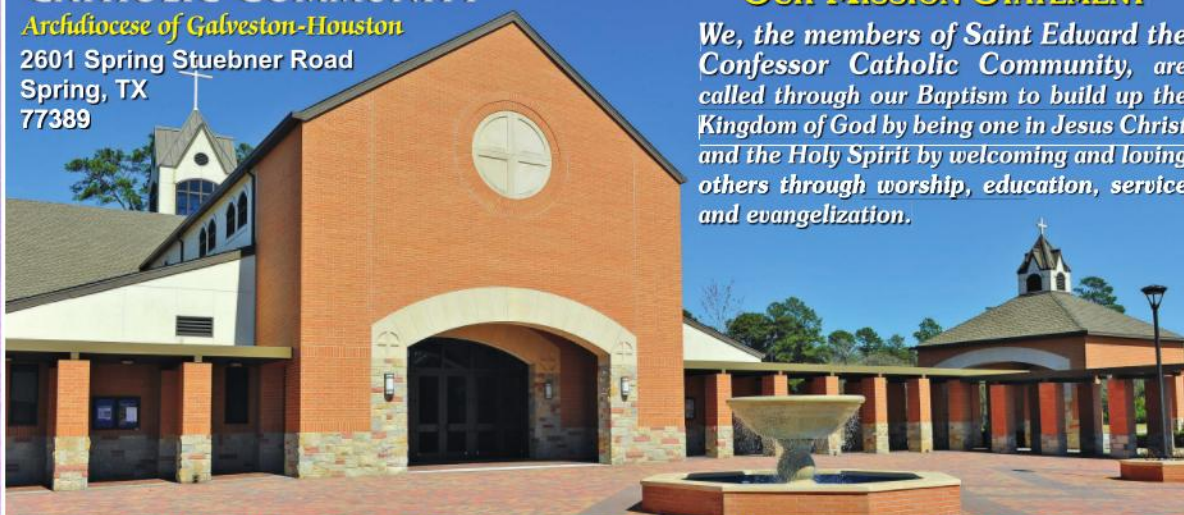

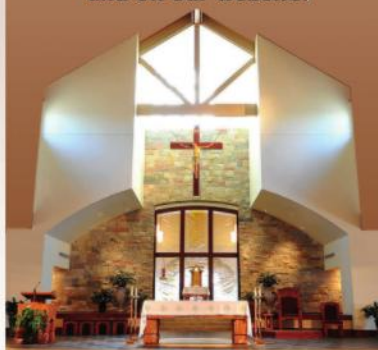

Dear Parishioners,

Welcome to the New Liturgical Year with this great journey of Advent.

Brothers and sisters, John the Baptist makes this call that is always valid and relevant as he prepares for the appearance of Jesus, the Messiah, and as we prepare for Christmas and the coming of the Lord at the end of time.

Let us be reminded that repentance is not a feeling, although it is often accompanied by feelings of sorrow and regret. Repentance usually involves three things: first, a change of mind – a new way of seeing; second, a change of heart – a new direction in life; and third, a change of behavior – a new way of life. If we go through repentance, we will always have conversion. We cannot repent without being converted. I hope that we take time to reflect on how we are being converted during this season of Advent.

Let us be aware that during this season of Advent, we prepare the way of the Lord to our lives and to our society by changing our way of thinking – we have to be converted from our way of having the primacy in our lives of money, power, pleasure, and popularity. We must change our attitude – we have to be converted from having the “me first, me second, and me always” or “my family first, my family second, and my family always” attitude and begin to share and help others in their needs. And we must change our behavior – we have to produce good fruits as evidence of our repentance. So really, repentance is not a feeling, it is a way of life.

Let us pray that we may have the courage and the willingness to persevere in repentance especially during this season of Advent. May we truly have the change that we need to have in our lives so that we may meet Jesus and welcome Him.

May we all continue to have a blessed Advent Season.

programs. I am happy to have Annette on our staff and I am sure you will see her passion for Christ when you meet her.

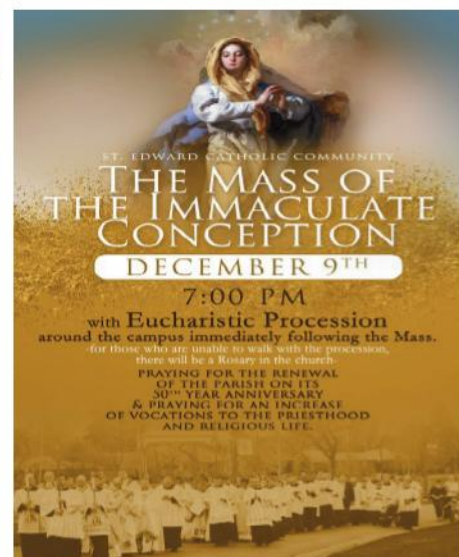

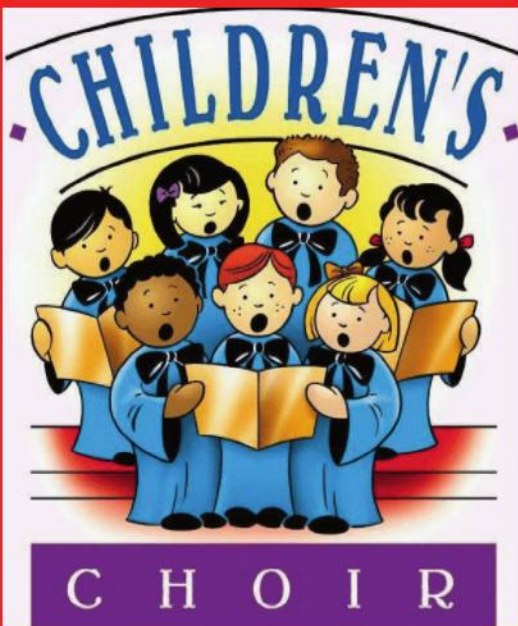

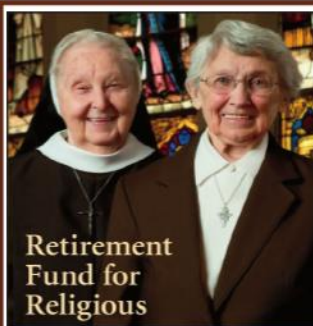
