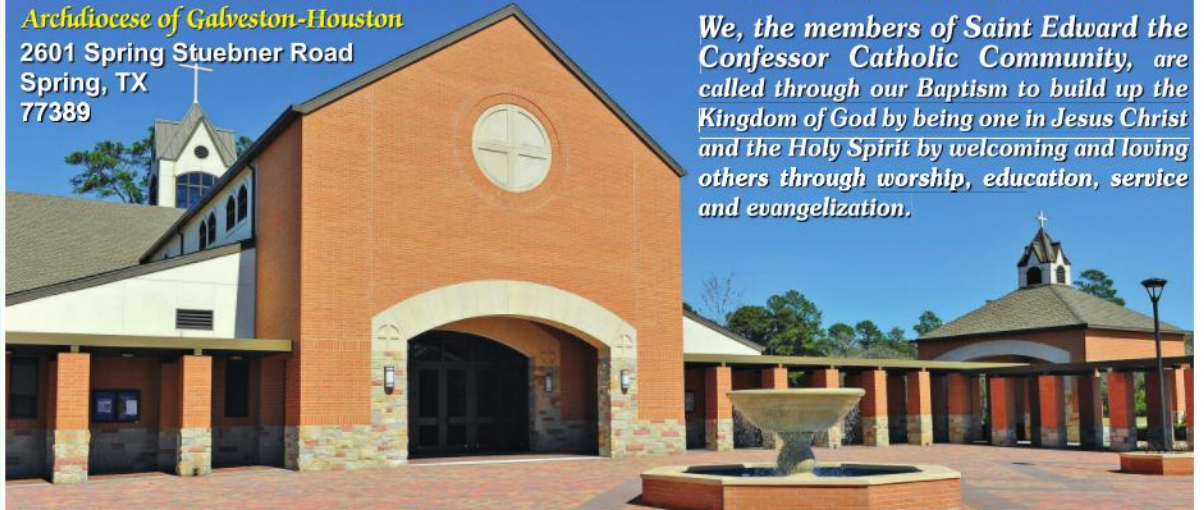

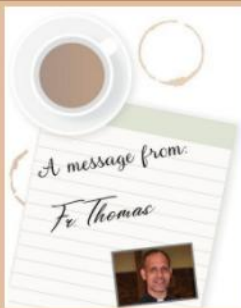

With this New Year 2020, we welcome the end of one calendar year and the beginning of a new one. In this New Year we share a common hope, that we can begin again. That hope can find its ultimate fulfillment by turning to the One who can make all things new, Jesus Christ.

Nations use different calendars, but the passing of one year to the next is universally marked by a deliberate period of reflection concerning the year that passed and a pledge to begin anew, to change, in this New Year. This is because we all hunger to be made new and naturally, we all know that means we must change within if we want to experience change around us.

GK Chesterton once wrote: *"The object of a New Year is not that we should have a new year. It is that we should have a new soul and a new nose; new feet, a new backbone, new ears, and new eyes. Unless a particular man made New Year resolutions, he would make no resolutions. Unless a man starts afresh about things, he will certainly do nothing effective. Unless a man starts on the strange assumption that he has never existed before, it is quite certain that he will never exist afterwards. Unless a man be born again, he shall by no means enter into the Kingdom of Heaven."*

In the third chapter of John's Gospel we read about an encounter between Nicodemus and Jesus. Jesus tells this devout Jewish leader, *"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God."* He was somewhat confused by these words, and *"Nicodemus said to Jesus, 'How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?'"* (John 3:5)

The same John, in the Book of Revelation, gives us a vision of the ultimate fulfillment of the desire which surfaces during every commemoration of every New Year, that wonderful day when the Lord will return and make all things new. *He says: "Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and the sea was no more. And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband; and I heard a great voice from the throne saying, 'Behold, the dwelling of God is with men. He will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself will be with them; he will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain any more, for the former things have passed away. And he who sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new.'"* (Rev 21: 1-5)

In a rare moment of reflection and honest self-assessment, we admit our failures of our last year. We pledge to learn from them and move toward a better future. We all want to be better, to live our lives more fully and to love one another more selflessly.
