



Dear Parishioners,

We are in Ordinary Time of our Liturgical Calendar 2020. I invite you to persevere on the celebration of the Sacraments and on receiving grace from God particularly through the celebration of the Holy Mass.

The following are quotations from the Catholic Guide:

What fruits are derived from holy Mass? By means of the Mass, the fruits of the sacrifice of the cross are applied to our souls.

The sacrifice on the cross—the passion and death of Christ—is the gold mine of graces; Holy Mass is the machinery that takes the gold out for us. At Mass a torrent of graces flows from the altar of God to enrich men. God makes use of other means of grace, such as prayer; but in no other means are graces applied to us so generously.

AT MASS we particularly obtain:

(a) Grace to repent of mortal sin.

It is not necessary to be in the state of grace to hear Mass; the sinner does not commit a fresh sin by doing so; on the contrary he obtains the grace of conversion. Upon the cross Christ cried: "Father, forgive them;" at Mass He utters the same prayer on behalf of those present.

- (b) Forgiveness of venial sins for those who are in the state of grace.
 - St. Augustine said that one "Our Father" prayed with devotion would expiate the venial sins of a whole day; how much more effective would be the Mass, which is the supreme prayer offered to God!
- (c) Remission of the temporal penalty due to sin.

The penitent thief, who was present at the Sacrifice of the Cross, was quickly admitted into heaven, with the penalties due his sins all forgiven.

Through the Holy Mass you are preserved from many dangers and misfortunes which would otherwise have befallen you. You shorten your purgatory by every Mass.

During the Holy Mass you kneel amid a multitude of holy angels, who are present at the Sacrifice with reverential awe. Through Holy Mass you are blessed in your temporal goods and affairs. When you hear Holy Mass devoutly, offering it to Almighty God in honor of any particular saint or angel, thanking God for the favors bestowed on him, etc., you afford that saint or angel a new degree of honor, joy and happiness, and draw his/her special love and protection on yourself.

Dear brothers and sisters, these and many other effects are fruits for us whenever we celebrate the Sacrament of the Eucharist and all are graces from God. Let us, with renewed enthusiasm worship our Lord in the Holy Mass. God is granting us countless opportunities for grace; let us not take them for granted.


IMPOSTER PRIEST EMAIL/ TEXTING SCAMS




