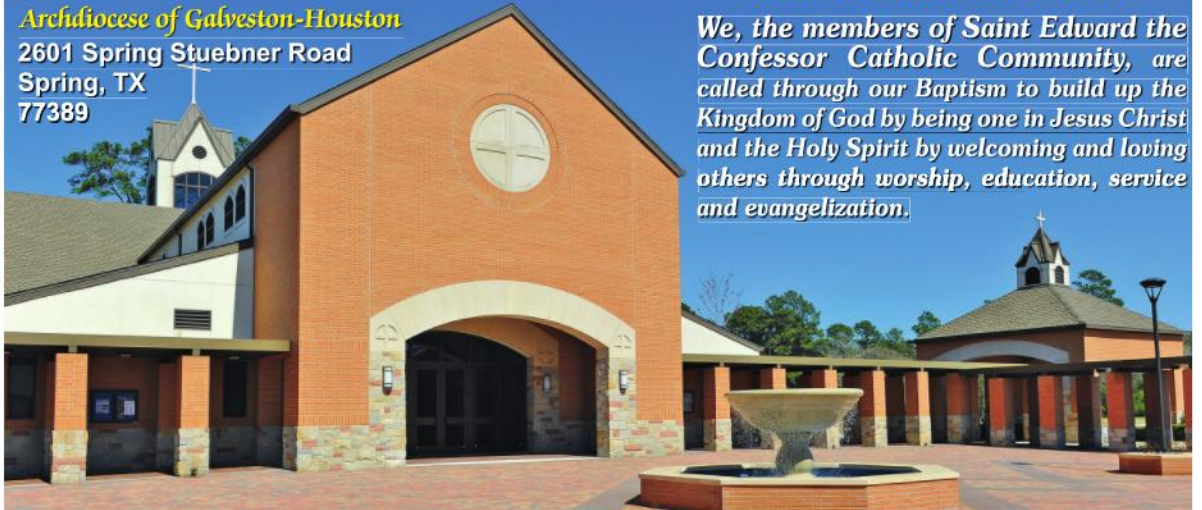

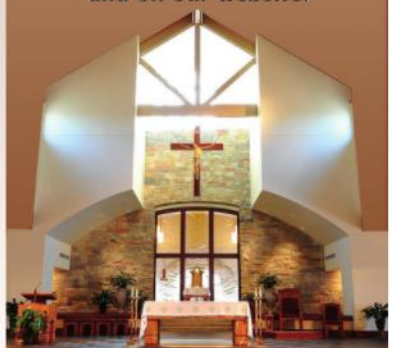

Christians across the globe have already started Lent, the season of preparation before Easter. Beginning on Ash Wednesday – which was February 26 this year – the 40-day period sees many Christians partake in a season of prayer, fasting and repentance. These exercises not only discipline oneself, but also allow us time to reflect on the life, words and sacrifices of Jesus Christ.

For Pope Benedict XVI, “Lent is like a long ‘retreat’ during which we can turn back into ourselves and listen to the voice of God, in order to defeat the temptations of the Evil One. It is a period of spiritual ‘combat’ which we must experience alongside Jesus, not with pride and presumption, but using the arms of faith: prayer, listening to the word of God and penance.”

And for Saint Mother Teresa of Calcutta, “Lent is the time for greater love, listen to Jesus’ thirst... ‘Repent and believe’ Jesus tell us. What are we to repent? Our indifference, our hardness of heart. What are we to believe? Jesus thirsts even now, in your heart and in the poor – He knows your weakness. He wants only your love, wants only the chance to love you.”

For those embarking on the annual Lenten journey, let us walk with Jesus through our threefold practice of Lent: prayer, fasting and penance.

Prayer for Vocations²

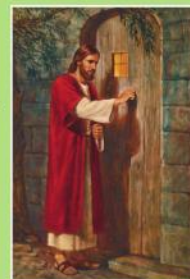
