**Today begins Vocation Awareness Week**

Did you know that in our country, compared to 60 years ago, there are 20,000 fewer priests and 129,000 fewer religious sisters? At the same time, the Catholic population has grown steadily. During Vocation Awareness Week, please pray that young people in today's society will hear and respond to God's call. And do your part to encourage them to consider the priesthood and religious life.

**One Vocation Leads to Another**

"Let us not forget that Christian marriage is a vocation to holiness in the full sense of the word, and that the example of holy parents is the first condition favorable for the flowering of priestly and religious vocations." – Pope Benedict XV

**Your Unique Mission**

Why does it matter that people discover their God-given vocations? Because the Church relies on the unique contribution of every soul. As St. John Henry Newman famously reflected: "God has created me to do some special service; God has committed some work to me *which has not been committed to another*. I HAVE A MISSION."

**A Plenary Indulgence**, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who on any and each day from November 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed. On All Souls' Day a plenary indulgence is granted to those who devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed.

To acquire a plenary indulgence it is necessary also to fulfill the following three conditions: sacramental Confession, Eucharistic communion, and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father. The three conditions may be fulfilled several days before or after the performance of the visit; it is, however, fitting that communion be received and the prayer for the intention of the Holy Father be said on the same day as the visit.
