


The Lord's Ascension, which we celebrate on May 13th, is the visible departure of Jesus to His Father and marks the end of His appearances to the disciples on earth.

Take consolation in knowing that Jesus will come again! The time between His visible ascension and His return at the end of time is the era of the Church. This is the Church's opportunity and obligation to preach repentance and belief in the Gospel to all the nations. Don't forget what Jesus commanded the disciples to do, "observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:20). 
#### Why We Celebrate the Ascension on Sunday and Not Thursday

The Church's Code of Canon Law includes the Ascension of Jesus among the solemn feast days to be observed by Latin-rite Catholics throughout the universal Church. The text also remarks, "The conference of bishops can abolish certain holy days of obligation or transfer them to a Sunday with the prior approval of the Apostolic See" (Canon 1246.2).

In many places, as we have seen, the Ascension has been transferred to Sunday, and for a twofold reason. First, holy days are to be observed with the same regard as Sundays. The Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are to refrain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God ... and [partake in] the appropriate relaxation of mind and body" (No. 2185). This is often impossible on weekdays, so moving the feast to a Sunday makes a great deal of sense. The second reason for moving the feast allows those who cannot attend Mass on Thursday to share an important, common prayer experience.





#### SECOND COLLECTION TODAY
