



Dear Parishioners,

I would like to express my gratitude to all for your prayers and best wishes on my 17th anniversary of the Ordination to the Priesthood. Thank you for your love and support!

Today we are celebrating our triune God, a God that can

never be fully explained and therefore never fully understood. On the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I am reminded of a story about St. Augustine from his treatise on the Trinity entitled, De Trinitate. According to the story, while walking on the beach, St. Augustine was contemplating the mystery of the Trinity. During the walk he saw a boy who had dug a hole in the sand and was pouring water from the ocean into the hole. 


Senior Saints Welcome Back!


