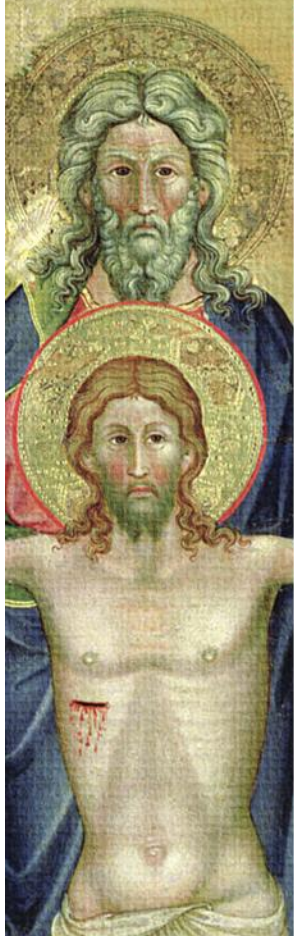

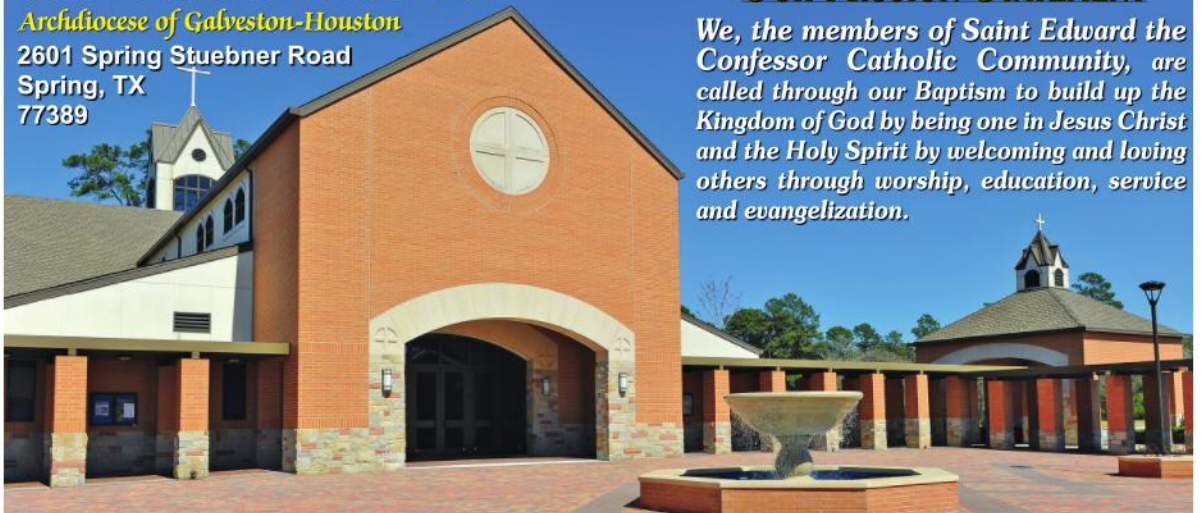

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to express my gratitude to all for your prayers and best wishes on my 17th anniversary of the Ordination to the Priesthood. Thank you for your love and support!

Today we are celebrating our triune God, a God that can never be fully explained and therefore never fully understood. On the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I am reminded of a story about St. Augustine from his treatise on the Trinity entitled, *De Trinitate*. According to the story, while walking on the beach, St. Augustine was contemplating the mystery of the Trinity. During the walk he saw a boy who had dug a hole in the sand and was pouring water from the ocean into the hole. St. Augustine asked the boy, "What are you doing?" and the boy replied, "I'm going to pour the entire ocean into this hole." St. Augustine said, "That is impossible! You cannot fit the entire ocean in that tiny hole you made." And the boy replied, "And you sir, cannot fit the Trinity in your tiny little brain." The story concludes by saying that the boy vanished, and St. Augustine had been talking to an angel.

Brothers and sisters, no matter how hard we try to explain it, we will not be able to grasp the full meaning of the Trinity with only our minds. We can, however, fully fall in love with Him using our hearts. Let us be aware that the Trinity is not a problem or a mystery that has to be solved; rather, it is a mystery that has to be professed and appreciated in our daily Christian lives. We came from the love of God, were redeemed by the love of God, and are now guided by the love of God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We are now invited to respond to that love by a life lived in love. Let us then live our life as a response to God who has generously given us hope. Someday we may truly be united with one another, and with Him, in His Heavenly kingdom where we will live forever in love.

End of the Year Work!

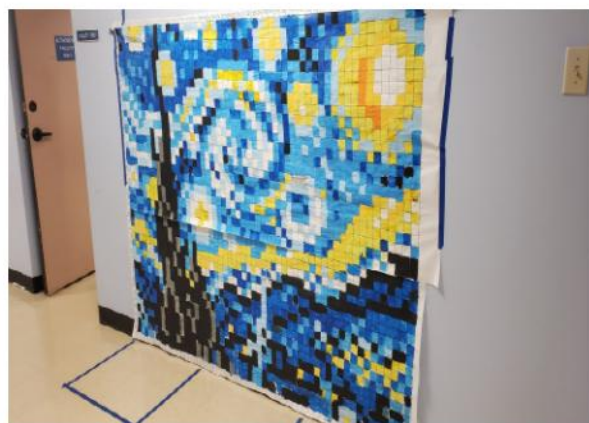
