



**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:** Today, we celebrate the solemn feast of *Corpus Christi*. This feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. This feast is celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday, in the USA it is transferred to the Sunday following that feast.

This feast invites us to focus on the Holy Eucharist and the Church. The opening prayer at Mass calls our attention to Jesus' suffering and death and our worship of Him, especially in the Eucharist. At every Mass our attention is called to the Eucharist and the Real Presence of Christ in it.

The secondary focus of this feast is the Body of Christ as it is present in the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with His disciples. He expresses this in the Gospels by using the metaphor of a body in which He is the head. This image helps keep focus on both the unity and the diversity of the Church.


It is three feasts in one: the feast of the Eucharistic sacrifice, feast of the Sacrament of the Eucharist, and the feast of the Real Presence of Jesus. It is a doctrinal feast established for three purposes: 1) to give God collective thanks for Christ's abiding presence with us in the Eucharist and to honor Him there; 2) to instruct the people in the mystery, faith, and devotion surrounding the Eucharist; and 3) to teach us to appreciate and make use of the great gift of the Holy Eucharist, both as a Sacrament and as a sacrifice.

When Jesus said "do this in memory of me," it is clear that He was not only referring to His actions relating to the bread and wine; He was asking His followers to live out this symbol of His life giving love. This is made very clear in the fourth gospel where, instead of the Passover meal, John reports that Jesus knelt down and washed the feet of His disciples and afterwards told them that they must do the same.

Since the very first days of the Church, our brothers and sisters have been gathering every week for this sacred meal. But when we routinely do anything, we often lose sight of just how wonderful it is. The Eucharist as a sacrifice and meal involves us not simply in a prayerful ritual, but also commits us to a way of relating to each other. If we are truly devoted to the Lord's presence in Holy Communion, then we will also be truly devoted to His presence in the community, especially in those who are most in need.

## CMGConnect

The CMGConnect **online** training **replaces** the former Safe Environment Program (VIRTUS "Protecting God's Children") that was previously offered through our Archdiocese. Individuals are now required to complete all Safe Environment Training **online**.

Education is a key element of the Safe Environment program. **All clergy, employees, contracted school personnel, volunteers, members of groups, movements, and organizations over the age of 18, who work, volunteer or participate in any capacity are required to complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training and a criminal background check before they may begin employment, volunteer, or participate with ministries, groups, movements, and organizations.**

The mandatory renewal training must be completed every 5 years and a new background check submitted before the 5 year expiration of prior training. The Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston Safe Environment compliance training and renewal training is a condition of employment and for volunteer ministry in the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston.



**Open House Volunteers**

St. Edward's 2021 Open House had members of Student Council and NHS students welcome incoming families and provided tours around our campus. Volunteers helped to make prospective students comfortable, while lowering the school and meeting teachers.

**Flag Duty**

Every week, two members of Student Council raise and lower the flag once a day. Members were taught how to raise, lower, fold, and treat the flag with respect and proper etiquette.

**Snack Attack Homeless Bags Easter Drive**

For our last and final service project, Student Council decided to collect bags made by junior high students. We dedicated this project to the homeless. Students collected items like, water, snack bars, toiletries, razors and proper cards, and packaged it into a bag that would be sent off and received by someone in need. Students collected over 178 bags to donate to Lower and Hubbs and Shoving Waters mobile shower ministry.
