A very big thank you to everyone for a very successful Lenten Parish Mission. We are grateful for Bishop Brendan Cahill for leading us into the time in our Church year when we prepare our hearts and our minds to journey with Jesus through His Passion, His Death, and ultimately to the glory of His Resurrection. Jesus Himself underwent such a period of preparation before He began His earthly ministry, traveling into the desert to fast and pray, seeking connection with His Father, and engaging with His great foe. We pattern our own time of preparation on His desert sojourn, taking the same forty days, and using His techniques of prayer and abstinence to grow closer with God, and perhaps confront some of our own personal shortcomings.

The scripture readings this weekend can help us express that, "Thirsting for you, my God." The imagery of thirst in relationship to God is most prominent in the psalms. Psalm 42 compares our desire to know God with the need of a thirsty deer for lifegiving water asking, "when can I see the face of God?" (Psalm 42: 3.) As human beings, on average, our bodies are over 60% water. We can survive for weeks without food of any kind, but only 3 days without water. It is not an exaggeration to say that water is one of the most vital elements to sustaining life. In comparing our need and desire for God to thirst, the psalmist emphasizes God's crucial life-giving power in our lives.

As we take up our Lenten journey to the cross on Calvary, then on to the empty tomb, we begin in the desert. Our personal desert is anywhere in our lives or in our hearts that feels barren, or hopeless, or lifeless. Our demons await us there, tempting and torturing us in our moments of need. But we do not travel to the desert alone. As we acknowledge our thirst for a relationship with God, we can accept His invitation to drink of the living water of His mercy and love. It is my hope for each of us that we can drink freely of this great gift, watering our desert and making it bloom.

I wish you and your loved ones Lenten blessings of good health, new hope, and a fruitful desert journey.

# MINISTRY MESSAGE

HE is here! Last Sunday we heard the wonderful scripture reading from the Transfiguration. "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here."

Peter was so overwhelmed to see Jesus, Moses, and Elijah that he wants them to be comfortable and to stay! He is then blessed to hear directly from the voice of God: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

Are we also happy to be in the presence of God during our Eucharistic Celebration. HE is here at every Mass where the Priest consecrates the bread and wine into the body & blood, soul & divinity of Jesus Christ. Do we just relish in the special experience. Are we like Peter and desire it to continue? Or do we not encounter the presence of Christ in our mass? Do we prepare ourselves? Are we open to His presence, even for the short time of Mass?

As we continue a year of Eucharistic Revival, perhaps we are called to examine our views and feelings of the Eucharist. Since our baptism, and because of our baptism, we participate in both the saving power of the cross, and the resurrection! Do we also allow the transformation of the bread and wine into Jesus Christ to continue to work in us, to transform us into the best person God has called us to be. Luke 22: 19 says, "then he took the bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me."

Our participation involves us surrendering our faults, to be transformed into something more, then called to join Jesus' mission helping others.




