

#### DSF INCENTIVES: DID YOU KNOW?

- 1. There is a 75% rebate on every dollar a parish raises over goal.

- 3. The parish in each vicariate with the greatest increase in participation over DSF 2021 will receive a \$5,000 check.
- 4. Any parish that donates some or all of its rebate to another parish through twinning will be allowed a double deduction for purposes of Cathedraticum.




