Dear Parishioners,

I wish you all a Merry Christmas. "Who is the Messiah they are praying for?" There are many great movies about Jesus in different languages. Among them are the monumental movies like The Greatest Story Ever Told, (1965), King of Kings, (1927) and Jesus of Nazareth (1977).

In the beginning of The Greatest Story Ever Told, there is a scene in which we see the Israelites praying for a Messiah. They are not just praying, rather they are crying out for the promised Messiah to save them. This prayer reminds us of the prayer given in the Book of the Prophet Isaiah where we read. "O! that you would rend the heavens and come down!" (64:1).

As they are praying, a Roman centurion asks King Herod, "Who is the Messiah they are praying for?" Immediately Herod replies. "Someone who will never come!" King Herod and so many others thought that the Messiah would never come. But in the fullness of time. God sent His only-begotten Son to this world to be born of a virgin in Bethlehem. And when Jesus, the Son of God, was born, there was a celebration in heaven. Angels appeared in the skies and sang, "Glory to God in the highest and peace on earth to those with whom He is pleased" (Lk 2:14).
