This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This feast reminds us of the incredible gift Jesus left us in the Eucharist — His real presence under the appearance of bread and wine. In every Mass, we are invited not only to receive Christ but to become more like Him: to live in love, service, and unity.

As we adore and receive the Body of Christ, may we also become the Body of Christ for the world — broken, shared, and given for others. The Real Presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist is not a symbol or a mere remembrance; it is Jesus Himself—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity—truly present under the appearances of bread and wine.

Jesus Himself declared in the Gospel of John: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world." (John 6:51) When many in the crowd found this teaching difficult and walked away, Jesus did not call them back to explain it differently. He let them go, affirming that His words were meant literally. He wanted His followers to believe, not only with their minds but with their hearts, in this sacred mystery.

St. Paul, too, emphasizes the seriousness of this belief. He writes: "Anyone who eats and drinks without discerning the body eats and drinks judgment on himself." (1 Cor 11:29)

What does this Real Presence mean for our lives?

- 1. It means God is with us not only spiritually, but physically. In the Eucharist, heaven touches earth. Jesus comes to dwell in us and among us. He is Emmanuel, the God who stays.
- 2. It transforms us Just as ordinary bread becomes the Body of Christ, we too, by receiving Him, are changed. We become more like Him—more patient, more forgiving, more compassionate.
- 3. It calls us to unity We who receive from the one bread become one body. The Eucharist is the sacrament of communion—communion with God and communion with one another.
- 4. It sends us forth At the end of every Mass, we are sent out with Christ within us, to be His presence in the world: in our homes, our workplaces, and wherever there is need.

Dear friends, let us never take this gift for granted. Every time we come to Mass, let us come with deep faith, humble hearts, and grateful souls. Let us prepare well confessing our sins when needed, praying with attention, and receiving Him with love.

And may the Eucharist truly become the source and summit of our Christian life.


