Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, we hear one of the most tender and important requests ever made to Jesus: "Lord, teach us to pray." In response, Jesus gives us the Lord's Prayer—a prayer not just to recite, but to live by. It is simple, yet it reaches the heart of our relationship with God as Father, our dependence on Him for daily needs, forgiveness, and guidance.

Jesus doesn't stop at teaching the words; He also teaches the attitude of prayer—persistent, trusting, and expectant. He invites us to ask, seek, and knock, assuring us that the Father delights in giving good things to His children. If we who are limited know how to care for those we love, how much more does our heavenly Father long to care for us?

I encourage each of you to deepen your daily habit of prayer. Prayer is not about eloquence or perfect timing. It is about relationship. Speak to God from the heart. Be honest. Be consistent. Even when you don't feel like praying—especially then—pray anyway. Like a child who runs into a parent's arms, run to God with trust.

In our busy and distracted lives, prayer anchors us. It reminds us who we are and whose we are. It teaches us to forgive, to be patient, and to live in hope. Let us never underestimate what God can do when we give Him our attention and our time.

This week, I invite you to pray the Lord's Prayer slowly and mindfully each day. Let it shape your heart and your actions.

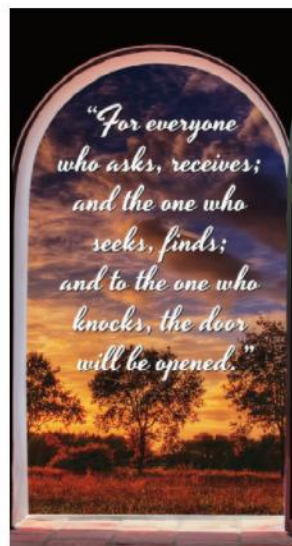

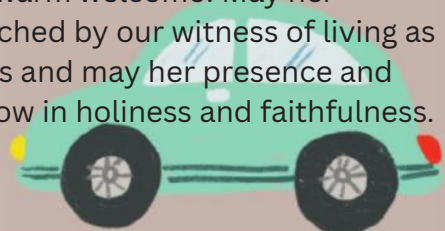
