Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are celebrating the Exaltation of the Cross this weekend, and it celebrates the discovery of the true cross of Jesus by St. Helena in 4th Century. This Feast reminds us that what the world sees as defeat, God transforms into victory. The Cross, a symbol of shame and death, becomes for us a sign of salvation, love, and hope. In Jesus' suffering and death, God's plan of redemption is fulfilled, and life triumphs over death.

Yet, if we are honest, we often shrink from the Cross. We prefer comfort over sacrifice, pleasure over pain, and success over failure. In our prayers, we ask for blessings, health, and happiness—but rarely for the strength to endure hardship or the courage to carry our own cross. We live in a culture that promotes quick solutions, instant gratification, and the avoidance of suffering. The Cross stands as a stark contradiction to that way of thinking.

But the Gospel tells us that there is no resurrection without Calvary and no crown without the Cross. True discipleship is not about running away from pain but about transforming it through love. When we embrace our crosses—whether they are daily struggles, sacrifices for others, or personal suffering—we are not glorifying pain for its own sake. We are uniting ourselves with Christ, allowing God's grace to work through our weakness.

The Exaltation of the Cross calls us to see suffering in a new meaning: not as a punishment or an obstacle, but to deeper love, greater faith, and eternal life. The Cross is not just a historical event; it is a daily invitation to die to selfishness and rise to new life in Christ.

This feast challenges us to not just wear the Cross as a medal, but to live its meaning. The Cross invites us to practice forgiveness, self-sacrifice and compassion. Believe that God can bring good out of our trials.

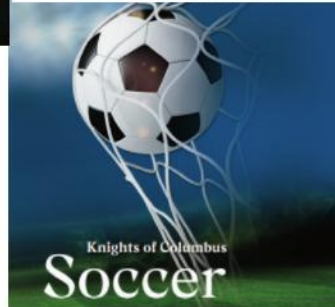

RESURRECTION WINDOW

The primary form is a butterfly, which is one of the oldest Christian symbols of the resurrection. The evolution of a butterfly from its cocoon is a reminder of Christ's rising from death and becoming a pure spirit form. Its placement on the west wall symbolizes the transition from this life to eternity.

CREATION WINDOW

The forms of the design represent the swirling of the galaxies at the inception of the creation of the universe. Its location is placed on the east wall to reflect sunrise, new day, and new life.
