The Counseling and Behavioral Health Clinic provides individual counseling, as well as workshops presentations for men, women and children. These services are provided by licensed clinicians who hold Master's degrees and a variety of state licenses and credentials. These include clinical social workers, and professional counselors. Bilingual clinicians are available to meet a growing need for Spanish language counseling in the community,

WE PROVIDE SUPPORT, GUIDANCE, AND INSIGHT FOR:
