

# 2026 Mass Intention Book

## Guidelines to Request a Mass Intention:

A person may request **up to five Mass intentions every six months**. Each family will be allowed a **total of 10 Mass intentions per year**. **One Mass intention** is spoken out loud **per Mass**. Each intention is limited to either **one name, a married couple, one group or one family name**. **One Mass every Sunday** is scheduled for the **intentions of our parishioners** known as "Pro Populo" (For the People) as required by the Church's Canon Law.

## Mass Intentions cannot be scheduled for:

Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Easter Sunday, Mother's Day, Father's Day, All Saints' Day, All Souls' Day, and Christmas. These Masses will be celebrated for the general intentions of our parish.
