

One of our parishioners has generously donated 500 books to our community for Advent renewal and reflection. The book - *The Early Church was the Catholic Church* by Joe Heschmeyer at Catholic Answers - tackles the question: "Did the early Church really believe what we do today?" Heschmeyer puts forward a convincing argument that the Church Fathers did indeed hold distinctly Catholic beliefs on the Eucharist, bishops, Mary, and much more.

If you've ever wondered or been asked "Where's that in the Bible?" or heard the objection "Catholics added stuff later" - this is the perfect book for you. Super readable - Heschmeyer writes like he talks on his podcast: clear, charitable, a little witty, zero jargon.
