Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel invites us to look at Jesus through the eyes of John the Baptist, who proclaims with simplicity and conviction: "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world." These words are not just a title for Jesus; they are an invitation for us to recognize who He truly is and what He comes to do in our lives.

The Lamb of God does not come with power or force, but with humility, mercy, and self-giving love. He comes to take away sin—not only the sins of the world in general, but the burdens we personally carry: our guilt, our fears, our failures, and our hidden wounds. Ordinary Time reminds us that God works precisely in the ordinary moments of our lives—our routines, struggles, relationships, and daily choices.

Spiritually, today's readings encourage us first to learn how to recognize Jesus. John recognized Him because he listened, prayed, and stayed attentive to God's movement. In the same way, we need quiet moments of prayer, Scripture reading, and silence so that we can see where the Lord is present and speaking to us.

Secondly, we are invited to point others to Christ. John did not draw attention to himself; he pointed to Jesus. Our faith becomes credible when our words and actions reflect kindness, forgiveness, patience, and compassion. Sometimes the most powerful witness is not what we say, but how we live.

Finally, allow Jesus, the Lamb of God, to take away what weighs you down. Bring Him your sins in confession, your worries in prayer, and your brokenness in trust.

He does not come to condemn, but to heal and restore. May this Ordinary Time become extraordinary because we walk each day with the Lamb who leads us to life. Amen.




