

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

“The people who sat in darkness have seen a great light.” - Mt 4:16

On this Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel reminds us that Christ enters the ordinary moments of life to bring extraordinary light. Jesus begins His public ministry not in places of power, but among ordinary people in Galilee, calling fishermen and transforming them into disciples. In a world often marked by division, confusion, and discouragement, the Gospel proclaims a clear message: repent, believe, and follow.

St. Paul urges us to be united in Christ, not divided by worldly labels or personal preferences. Prophet Isaiah announces that light has dawned upon those who walked in darkness. Today, that light is Jesus Himself, who still walks along the shores of our lives, calling us by name.

This Sunday invites us to reflect: Am I willing to leave behind what holds me back and follow Christ more faithfully? Ordinary Time reminds us that holiness is lived out daily—at home, at work, and in our community by choosing Christ again and again.

May this week be a time to walk in His light and to become witnesses of that light to others.




