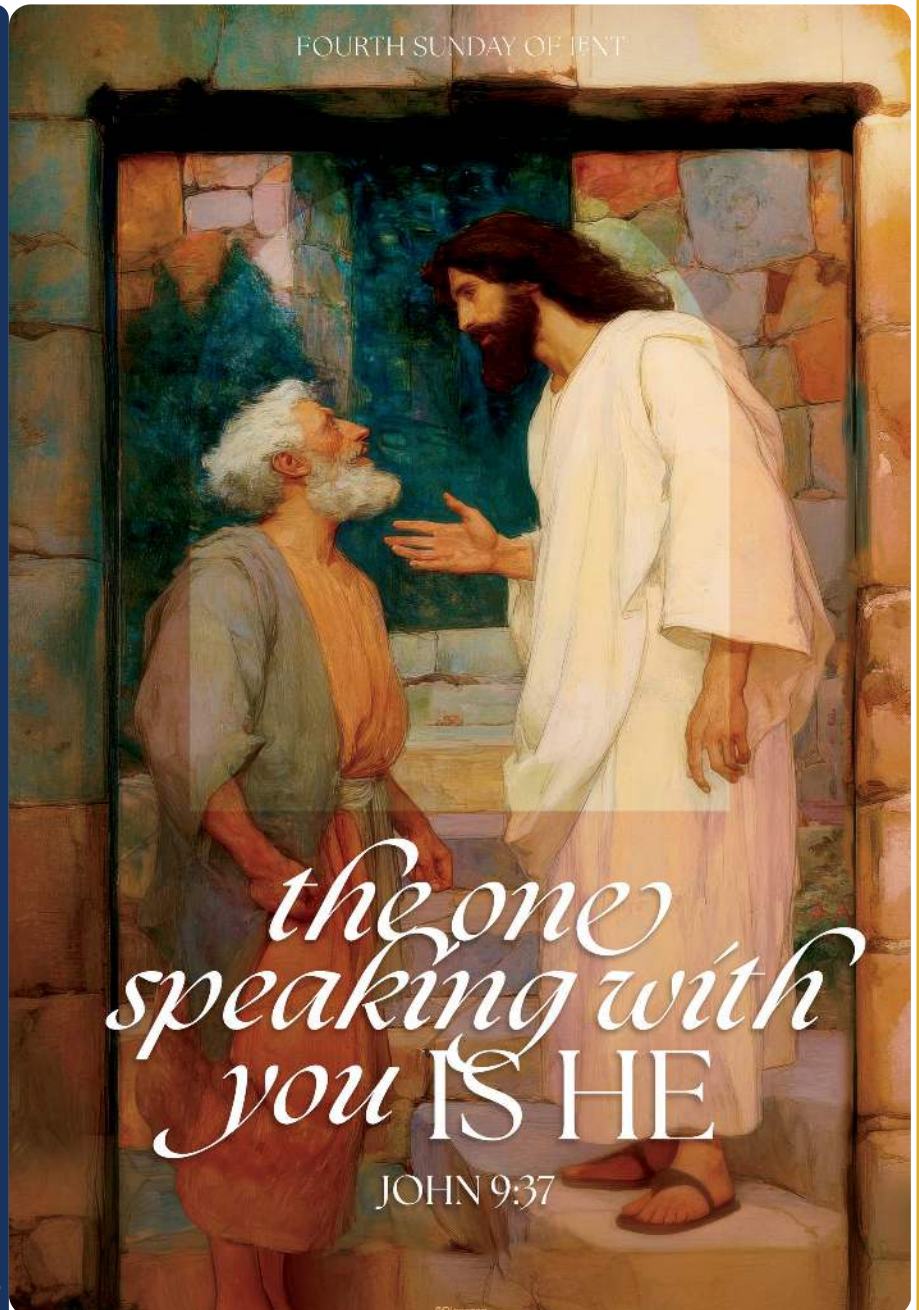

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Fourth Sunday of Lent is traditionally called Laetare Sunday, a day of rejoicing in the midst of our Lenten journey. The readings invite us to reflect on light, sight, and spiritual vision. In the Gospel, Jesus heals the man born blind. While the man gradually comes to see—both physically and spiritually—the Pharisees remain blind because their hearts are closed.

The miracle is not only about restoring physical sight. It is about awakening the heart to recognize God's presence. The man begins with limited understanding, calling Jesus simply "the man." Later, he recognizes Him as a prophet, and finally he proclaims, "Lord, I believe." His journey is the journey of every Christian: moving from darkness to light, from confusion to faith.

This message is especially meaningful for me personally, as I celebrate my birthday around this time. A birthday is not only a celebration of years lived; it is also a moment to thank God for the gift of life and to ask for deeper spiritual sight. Each year is another opportunity for God to open our eyes—to see His grace, His guidance, and His love more clearly.

Like the man in the Gospel, we are all blind in some ways. Sometimes we fail to see God working in our daily lives. Sometimes we judge too quickly or allow worries and past wounds to cloud our vision. Lent invites us to let Christ touch our eyes so that we may see with faith.

The practical question for us today is simple: Where do we need Jesus to open our eyes? Perhaps in our family relationships, in forgiveness, in gratitude, or in recognizing God's blessings.

On my birthday, my prayer is simple: that the Lord will continue to open my eyes as a priest and pastor, so I may serve His people with humility and love. I also pray that each of you may walk in the light of Christ. Please pray for me too!

As St. Paul reminds us: "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light."

May this Lenten season lead us all from blindness to faith, and from darkness into the radiant light of Christ.

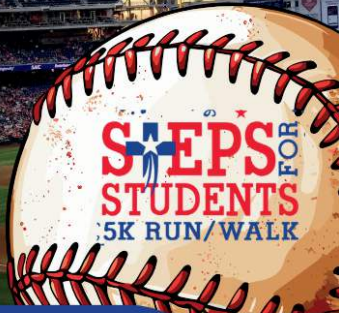

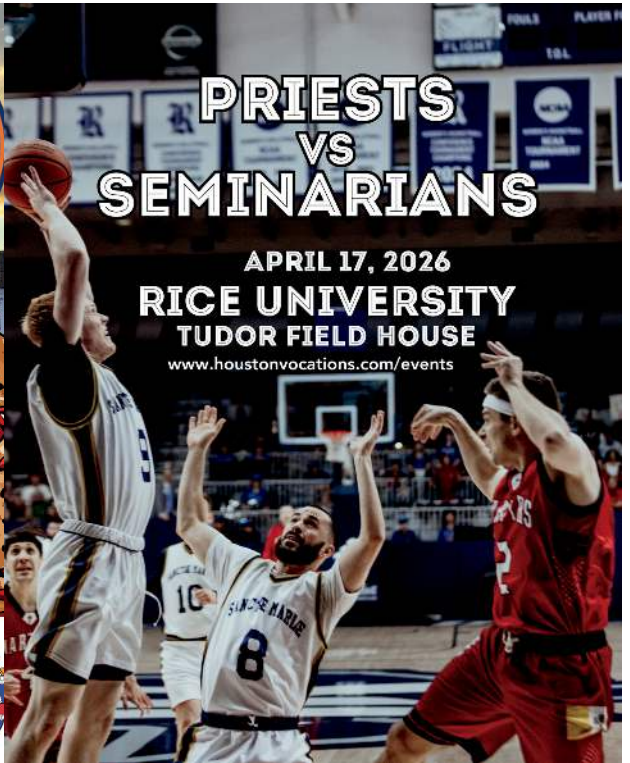
