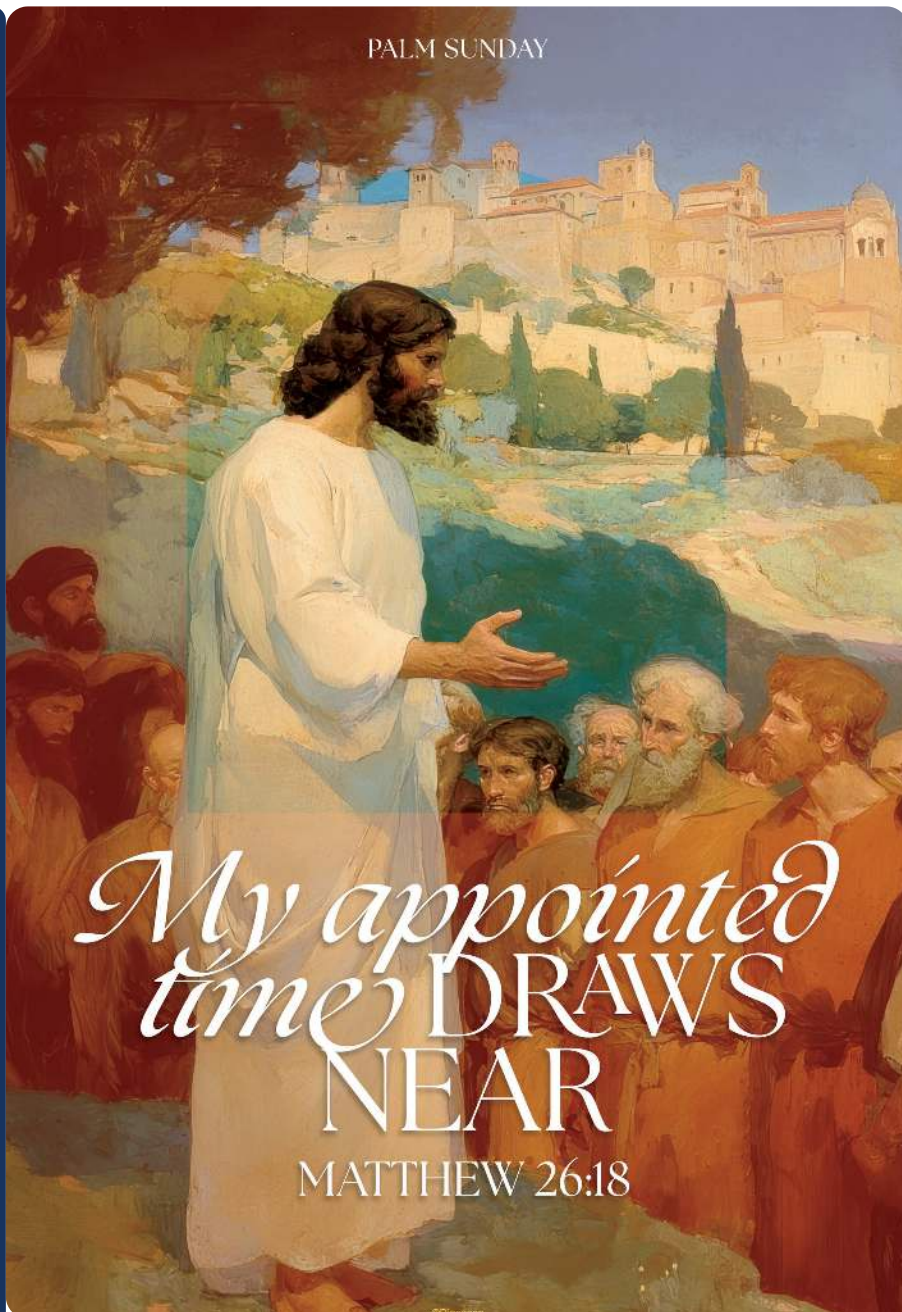

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter Palm Sunday, we stand at the threshold of the most sacred week of our faith—Holy Week. Today, we begin with joy, waving palms and proclaiming “Hosanna to the Son of David!” Yet, within moments, the Gospel leads us into the Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 26-27). The same crowd that praises Him will soon cry out, “Crucify Him.”

Palm Sunday reminds us of a deep truth: the human heart can be both faithful and fragile. At times, we welcome Christ with enthusiasm; at other times, through our sins, we turn away. And yet, Jesus remains faithful. He enters Jerusalem knowing the suffering ahead—yet He walks forward in love, humility, and obedience to the Father.

Here at St. Edward the Confessor, this Holy Week is an invitation—not just to remember, but to enter into the mystery.

A practical guide for our parish family:

- **Walk with Jesus daily** – Attend Mass during the week if possible, or spend time in quiet prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.
- **Celebrate the Triduum fully** – Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil are one single great liturgy. Make it a priority to participate.
- **Go to Confession** – Allow the Lord to cleanse your heart and prepare you for Easter joy.
- **Practice sacrificial love** – Reach out to someone in need, forgive someone, or offer a hidden act of kindness.
- **Reflect on the Passion** – Read the Gospel slowly this week.

Place yourself in the story. Where are you?

I invite each of you: do not stay on the sidelines. Walk with Jesus—from the palms to the Cross, and ultimately to the empty tomb.

May this Holy Week renew our hearts and deepen our love for Christ.

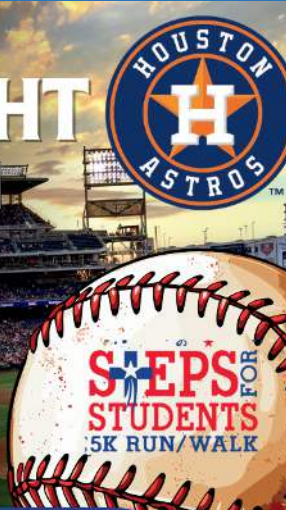

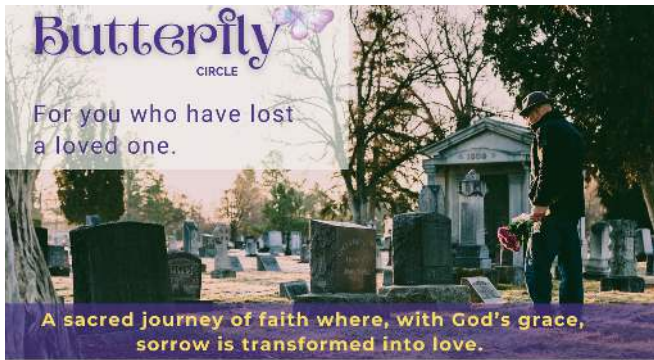
