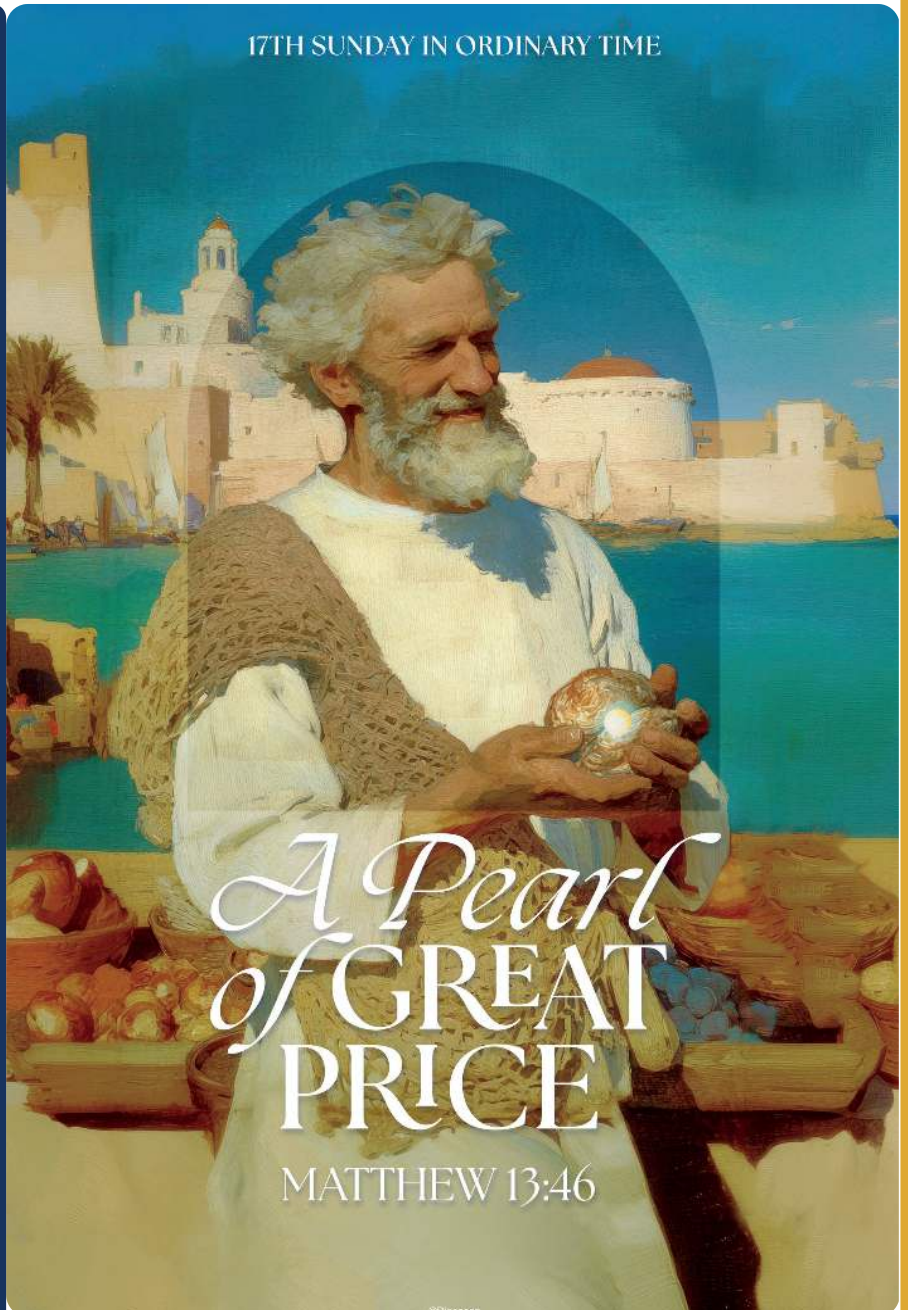

Brothers and Sisters,

In this weekend's Gospel (Matthew 13:44-52), Jesus compares the Kingdom of Heaven to both a treasure hidden in a field and to a merchant who discovers a pearl of great value. In both parables, the people joyfully give up everything they own because they know they have found something infinitely more precious.

The true story of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton illustrates this beautifully. The first native-born American saint, she was born into a wealthy and respected family. After the death of her husband, she encountered the Catholic faith through friends in Italy. When she decided to become Catholic in 1805, she lost the financial support of many relatives and friends, and opportunities that would have made life much easier. Yet she often said that the peace she found in Christ and His Church was worth every sacrifice. She gave up earthly security but discovered the priceless treasure of God's Kingdom. Her life became a blessing to countless children, families, and the Church in America.

We, too, are invited to ask ourselves: "What is the greatest treasure in my life? Is it wealth, success, comfort, or popularity? Or is it Christ?" The Kingdom of God is not something to be added to our lives after everything else; it is the treasure that gives meaning to everything else.

Every day we make choices about what we value most—money, success, comfort, or Christ. The Kingdom of God is not simply a future reward; it begins now whenever we place God first in our lives, seek holiness, forgive others, serve those in need, and remain faithful to the teachings of Christ.

May we have the wisdom to recognize the treasure God has placed before us in the Eucharist, in His Word, and in our daily opportunities to love and serve others. When Christ becomes our greatest treasure, every sacrifice becomes worthwhile, and our lives become rich soil as Jesus said in the parable of the sower and have fruitful harvest.

SACRAMENT INFORMATION

INTERVIEW INFORMATION FOR FIRST EUCHARIST

If your child or teen meets the requirements below, you may begin the registration process for sacrament preparation. Interviews will take place from May through July.

First Eucharist Requirements

- Must be baptized Catholic
- Must be at least 7 years old by September 1st
- Must be at least in 2nd grade when going through the preparation process
- Must have actively participated in faith formation with good attendance (parish, school, or homeschool) for at least one year immediately prior
- Must be actively participating in faith formation during the preparation process

Interview Registration

Interviewing is the first step in the registration process.

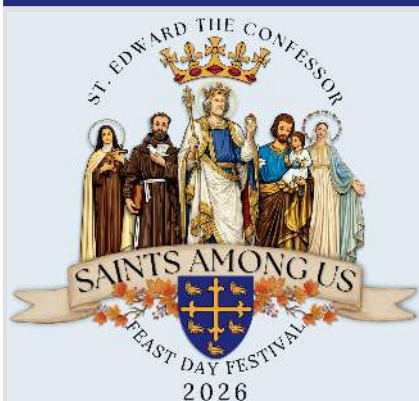
To sign up for an interview, please upload the following:

- Your child/teen's baptism certificate
 - If baptized at St. Edward the Confessor, upload the verification form provided on the website
- If your family is not registered at the parish, a permission letter from your pastor granting permission for your child/teen to prepare and celebrate the sacrament here
- If your child/teen participates in formation outside of our parish or school, a letter verifying participation from that program

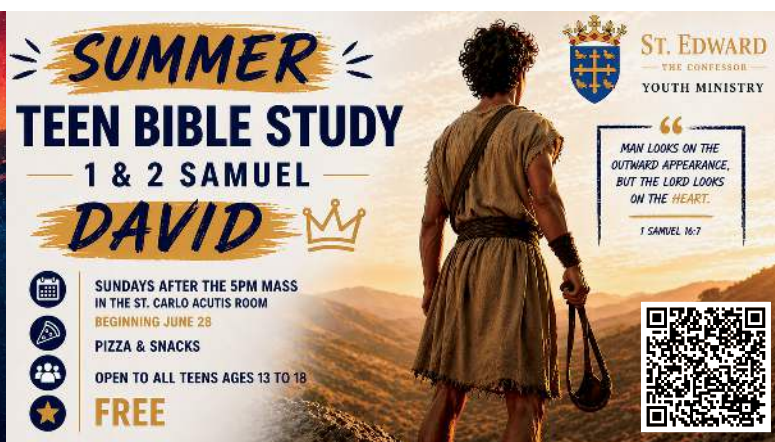
