

Pastor's Column : June 24 - 25, 2023

I hope all our fathers and grandfathers had a great day last Sunday. After Masses here and a Baptism, I went to see my mother. We had a nice dinner together.

Last week was filled with so many great things in our parish. The Forty Hours went better than I could possibly have imagined. It was so inspiring to see people in and out of the Church throughout the day and night, spending time in prayer.

The good number of people who came to the Evening Prayer Services was also great to see. It was wonderful to have so many priests come on the last night for the closing benediction. We heard some good homilies, too, from the priests who preached.

I cannot possibly thank all of you enough for supporting this prayerful endeavor. Whether you were part of the planning, helped organize or clean up afterward, or just took time to make a visit to our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, you helped make our Forty Hours a success. I am already looking forward to the next one!

Thanks also to the many people who came to Fr. Jay's anniversary Mass last Friday. There were lots of people from his family, as well as people from the many places he has served over his 25 years of priesthood. Our own parishioners made a great showing, too. Thanks also to everyone who helped with the reception afterward. It was a great celebration of the priesthood.

Many of you may recall the Parish Meeting over the winter at which our Finance Council made a nice presentation. Among the things discussed were some of our maintenance needs. Those present were asked to rank those needs in order of importance – and ranked the repaving of the parking lot as a high priority due to safety.

I am happy to report that our finance council has secured a grant of \$100,000 to help get this project moving. But – in order to have that grant paid to us – our parish has to show we can meet the remaining cost of over \$250,000. We have already begun making a plan to do this – with the assistance of our diocese.

While it will take time to put the whole plan into action, some people have already made donations to the parish for this purpose. I want to thank them from the bottom of my heart.

Recall that we are in the midst of our Bishop's Annual Appeal – with a goal of \$120,000. Fifty percent of any money donated to the appeal above that amount is rebated to the parish – and we have earmarked the parking lot as the recipient of that money. This means that gifts to the appeal can have the double effect of helping our own parish and the larger Church.

At this point, our parish has raised about \$110,000 towards the Bishop's Appeal. This means that we are very close to our goal – and can be pushed over it by last minute gifts. Keep in mind that our parish has benefitted greatly from the Bishop's Appeal in the past few years – making major repairs that would have been impossible without the help of our diocese. That's why it's a good idea for those of us who can to support the Appeal.

Please remember to pray a Hail Mary for me today – and every day. I keep all of you in my daily prayers, especially my Masses and Rosary. Let's also pray for peace – for good weather for our upcoming parish fair, and all those in need.

Saint of the Week: St. Thomas



St. Thomas is often referred to as Thomas the Apostle, Apostle of India or doubting Thomas. The latter of the names he is often associated with, overlooks the role he played as one of Jesus' apostles. As Christians and

followers of Jesus, it's common to doubt and question. If you look at all the apostles, they all have their own weaknesses, but this is what makes them human. It's also important for us to remember that not one of Jesus' apostles were perfect, in fact, they were all rather imperfect. Though St. Thomas may be often remembered for being doubtful, he should also be remembered for his courage and willingness to always serve Jesus. Like St. Thomas, may we allow God to transform our weaknesses into strengths to better serve Him and spread the Gospel with others.

Update from the Religious Education Program

Registration for 2023 - 2024

We still have fewer than 100 students registered for classes in the fall. Even if some families are moving before the fall, based on the enrollment for the past year, we are missing lots of registrations! We gained one first grader and now have eight (8) children registered for first grade. In a parish the size of St. John Vianney Parish, I am quite sure there are well more than eight children who will be in first grade in public school September.

Perhaps some of you know of children in your neighborhood. When you see their parents a friendly comment about registration for religious education may be just the reminder they need. Preparation for First Communion begins in 1st grade, so we want to be sure the 1st grade children will be in classes as of September.

The 2-page form is posted on our website at www.sjvianney.com and two-sided copies are on the table by the doors in the entrance area of the Church. If you use printed copies, be sure to complete the back! If a child is coming to our religious education program for the first time, please provide a copy of the child's Baptismal certificate. Thank you to those who have submitted the form and fee already.

If mail or drop off the registration and payment to the rectory, please write Religious Education on the envelope.

Looking for Volunteers for the 2023 – 2024 year

We need catechists, aides, and substitutes. Please, won't you please think about volunteering and pray about it? God may be calling you. We hope you will say yes! Even though current registration is low, we must be prepared for the children who will be registered later.

Anyone age 18 or older who will be around children will need to be fingerprinted and take a class. Since the process takes a little time, it is important to begin now so volunteers are eligible to be around children in September.

If any of you have experience working with children with special needs, we would very much like to hear from you. Our students with special needs are truly amazing and everyone who has worked with them will tell you what a blessing it was to work with them. Our program needs additional people with experience working with these children so we can offer them the best experience possible.

St. Josemaria Escriva | Catholic Saints

Called "the saint of ordinary life" by Pope John Paul II, St. Josemaria Escriva centered his ministry around a simple truth: each person can experience the extraordinary grace of holiness even in the ordinary events of day-to-day life.

St. Junípero Serra: A Man of God, A Mission of Love
