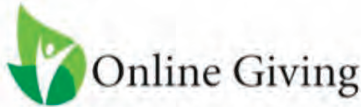
Congratulations Fr. Bede!

Pastor's Column : July 8 - 9, 2023

I hope everyone here had a great Independence Day. Due to a bulletin deadline imposed by that holiday, I actually had to write this column before July 4th. While I cannot yet tell you about my holiday, I do have a lot of things to share with you this week.

By now I'm sure everyone knows that our good Fr. Bede will be moving from our parish late this summer. Effective September 1st, he will assume the pastorate of the Churches of Our Lady of Victories in Baptistown (Frenchtown) and Saint Edward the Confessor in Milford, New Jersey. Let's keep him in our prayers as he takes on the added spiritual and administrative responsibilities that come with being a pastor.

On Sunday, August 27th, Fr. Bede will offer the 10 AM Mass in our Church. Following Mass, we will have a little going away party for him – with light breakfast – in the Parish Hall. It will be a time to thank Fr. Bede for his wonderful service to our parish, and to wish him well as he accepts this new role. Everyone is welcome – and I hope we all make an effort to be there.

Concurrent with Fr. Bede's move, Fr. Gregory Zanetti will move to our parish. He will become parochial vicar (associate pastor or curate – for those who remember those terms). While I am very sad to see Fr. Bede move on, I am excited to welcome Fr. Zanetti to our parish. Let's be sure to pray for him, and to make him welcome when he joins us here at St. John Vianney.

Remember that we have the Parish Fair this week from Tuesday through Saturday. I am looking forward to seeing lots of you and enjoying your company. I am also looking forward to some good carnival food! Please come out, join the fun, and help support our great parish!

Although July is not usually the time to think about school and CCD, I want to ask you to do so right now. Indeed, this is the time to make sure that all our parish children are registered for either our parish school or CCD program for the coming year. We want to make sure that all of them are learning about Jesus and our Catholic Faith and preparing for the sacraments – especially First Communion and Confirmation.

It has come to my attention that some people think that public school children need only attend CCD in the second and eighth grade (when they usually receive First Communion and Confirmation). THIS IS SIMPLY NOT TRUE! While we welcome school aged children to our CCD program at any age – even if they missed some years prior to this – the fact is that missing years of religious education leaves gaps in a child's religious education. Would any of us think it a good idea to allow a child to miss a couple of years of math? Science? Of course not!

With that in mind, let's make an all-out effort to see that all our parish children are receiving the religious education they deserve. As Jesus said: "let the children come to me, and do not prevent them." Making sure that our children – and grandchildren – are registered for CCD classes is a big way to do this.

Of course, the children in our parish school have religion class every day. This is one of the wonderful perks of going to Catholic School. But for the many children who attend public school – as I did most of my childhood – our parish offers CCD classes to help them learn their faith. Being a CCD graduate myself, I know how important this is! If you need help registering a child for CCD, just call the parish office or check the parish website. We will be happy to help you. The same goes for registering children in our parish school. It is a privilege for our parish to help our families share our faith with their children.

Finally, please remember to say a Hail Mary for me today, and every day. Why not add one for Fr. Bede and Fr. Greg as they transition to new parishes. Let's also pray for the sick, for good weather for our fair, and for peace in our troubled world.

Saint of the Week: St. Henry

St. Henry was the emperor of the Holy Roman Empire. He studied with St. Wolfgang and always had a deep interest in holy affairs. On his way back from conflict one time he stopped at the abbey of Monte Cassino,

which was founded by St. Benedict. While there, St. Henry fell ill, and it is known that St. Benedict cured him with combining medicinal herbs and the power of prayer. St. Henry went on to grow in faith from the experience, founding the See of Bamberg, creating its cathedral and much more. St. Henry is well known throughout the world to have been a just ruler and prayerful man. May we look to him as an example of finding balance and integration between our faith and daily lives.

Update from the Religious Education Program

Registration for 2023 – 2024

We now have exactly 100 students registered for classes in the fall. Even if some families are moving before the fall, based on the enrollment for the past year, we are missing lots of registrations. We gained another first grader and now have nine (9) children registered for first grade. As I wrote last week, in a parish the size of St. John Vianney Parish, I am quite sure there are well more than nine children who will be in first grade in public school September. Perhaps some of you know of children in your neighborhood who may not yet have been registered. Your assistance helping spread the word about registration would be most appreciated!

The 2-page form is posted on our website at www.sjvianney.com and two-sided copies are on the table by the doors in the entrance area of the Church. If you use the printed copies, be sure to complete the back! If a child is coming to our religious education program for the first time, please provide a copy of the child's Baptismal certificate. Thank you to those who have submitted the form and fee already.

If mail or drop off the registration and payment to the rectory, please write Religious Education on the envelope.

Looking for Volunteers for the 2023 – 2024 year

We need catechists, aides, and substitutes. Please, won't you please think about volunteering and pray about it? God may be calling you. We hope you will say yes! Even though current registration is low, we must be prepared for the children who will be registered later.

Anyone age 18 or older who will be around children will need to be fingerprinted and take a class. Since the process takes a little time, it is important to begin now so volunteers are eligible to be around children in September.

If any of you have experience working with children with special needs, we would very much like to hear from you. Our students with special needs are truly amazing and everyone who has worked with them will tell you what a blessing it was to work with them. Our program needs additional people with experience working with these children so we can offer them the best experience possible.

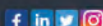
