# Thoughts From God's Garden Sr. Gabriela of the Incarnation, O.C.D. Carmel in New Jersey

NEW JERSEY is called the Garden State for good reason. Inside the Garden State there is another garden, God's Garden, better known as the Carmel of Mary Immaculate and St. Mary Magdalen. "Carmel" is a Hebrew word meaning "the Garden of God". A "Carmel" is a monastery of the Carmelite Order, named for Mount Carmel in the Holy Land. The Carmel of Mary Immaculate is in Flemington, in Hunterdon County, and it is the home to a dozen contemplative Nuns who devote their lives to praying for the Church and the world.

THE CARMELITE ORDER began on Mount Carmel around 1208 and a reformed branch was established by St. Teresa of Avila in Spain in 1562. The best-known Carmelite is St. Therese of the Child Jesus, the Little Flower, who was born 150 years ago. We Carmelites in Flemington carry on their charism of prayer and community life in the solitude of the cloister, and, like Therese, we try to be Love in the Heart of the Church.



# Update from the Religious Education Program

### Looking ahead to September 2023

The 2023 – 2024 year will begin with a parent meeting for parents with children in grades 1 through 8. The meeting has been scheduled for Monday, September 11, 2023, beginning at 6:15 and will be held in the Church. We hope most of you can arrange to attend.

Although classes began at 6:00 p.m. in prior years, it seems the 6:00 p.m. start time has been challenging for some parents and for some catechists. To help with the time challenges, the start time for classes for the 2023 – 2024 year will be 15 minutes later, with classes beginning at 6:15 p.m. The class end time will remain at 7:15 p.m.

### Registration for 2023 - 2024

As of this writing, only 133 students have been registered. Since we had over 200 students last year, it seems we are missing quite a few children.

The grade level with the least number of registered students is 1st grade with only 9 students. The number has not increased for a few weeks. While it is possible there are just not many Catholic children born in 2017 who attend public school and live in or around Colonia, nine seems terribly low. There were 33 in first grade religious education classes this past year. Please, if you have a child who will be attending 1st grade in public school in September, the time to register him or her is now!

The St. John Vianney Religious Education Program is an eight-year program, beginning in grade one and continuing through grade eight. We encourage each child to begin attending classes in first grade and attend each successive year through eighth grade.

To appropriately plan for next year, it is critical that we know how many students will be coming for each grade level. Unlike an employer that might be able to add shifts or hire additional employees, with a program run entirely with volunteers from the parish, adapting to an increase in students in August or September would pose serious challenges. Therefore, we ask that you please help us by registering now! If you know parents whose children may not have registered, please let them know that registering before the end of July will help make the program run more smoothly in September.




