

Pastor's Column: August 5 - 6, 2023

We all know that, before ascending to Heaven, Our Lord Jesus Christ told His disciples to spread the Gospel to all people. Strengthened by the Holy Spirit, those disciples made a great start at this mission. Within a generation after Jesus' Resurrection and Ascension, the Gospel had been preached in most of the Roman Empire, and many people had been converted to Christ.

These days, the Church continues the mission that the apostles began in many ways. One of them is the annual Mission Co – op Plan. As part of this plan every parish in our country – and in many others, too – is visited by a missionary who preaches about the missions at Sunday Mass. A second collection is then taken to support the work of that missionary and his or her community.

On August 19 – 20, our parish will welcome a missionary priest who will preach at all or our Masses. His name is Fr. Matthew Munishi and he is a priest of the Diocese of Moshi – Kilminjaro. Fr. Matthew's diocese is in Tanzania, East Africa – and includes Mount Kilminjaro.

The diocese of Moshi – Kilminjaro has a Catholic population of about a million people. It covers some 5,029 square kilometers. There are many seminarians and educating them is essential to the future of the diocese. A number of hospitals, health clinics, regular parishes, and mission stations are also served by this mission diocese. I encourage everyone who can to support the missionary work of the Church. Not all of us can go to the missions, but all of us can support them through our prayers and, in many cases, financial offerings. In doing so, we continue that great mission that Jesus gave to us through His first disciples.

Over the years, I have come to believe that the Mission Co – op Appeal should also make us think about ways we can be missionaries right here in our own community. One way is making sure that our children or grandchildren are enrolled in Religious Education (CCD) Classes or Catholic School. Another is encouraging others to come to Church with us. Still another is being ready to respectfully and politely share our Faith with others when the opportunity presents itself. With so many people who have fallen away from the Faith – or never been introduced to it – there is a lot of mission work to do right in our own backyard. Strengthened by the Spirit – Who came to us in Confirmation – we can do our part to spread the Gospel.

Speaking of missionary work and spreading the Gospel – remember that RCIA will begin again this autumn. RCIA is the process by which converts are welcomed into the Catholic Church. I am already working with one person and have another who is interested for this year. If you know of someone who has never been Baptized and would like to be – or who was Baptized in another denomination and wishes to become Catholic – or even someone who was Baptized Catholic but never received any other sacraments (First Communion or Confirmation) – RCIA is for them. You can either refer them to me or call me on their behalf. I will be very happy to help them!

This Monday morning, I will be leaving for my vacation. I will be taking a road trip way out west – to North Platte, Nebraska. If you like freight trains, it's a great place to go. On the way there and back, I will stop at some other train watching locations. I will be back in time for the Mission Co – op Appeal the weekend of August 19 – 20.

I always have lots of quiet time for prayer on these road trips and will include all of you in my prayers each day. Please remember to say a Hail Mary for me today – and every day. Let's also pray for Fr. Matthew and the missions and all the prospective converts among us. Finally, let's pray for our parish and for peace.

St. Jane Frances was married with six children and lived a happy life. When her husband died, she fell into intense mourning for a long time. It was when she met St. Frances de Sales that her heart was softened again, and she got back to living a very devout life.

St. Jane Frances served under the wisdom of St. Frances de Sales and founded the Congregation of the Visitation for women who wished to live a religious life like her which eventually turned into a convent. Over her lifetime, through many hardships, St. Jane Frances was intensely committed to her faith in God. By the time she died St. Jane Frances has founded about 85 convents. May we look to St. Jane Frances de Chantal whenever we feel overwhelmed by the circumstances of life, for like her we can overcome anything through our faith in the Lord.


