

Pastor's Column: August 12 - 13, 2023

Please remember that Tuesday, August 15th, is the Solemnity of the Assumption. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, meaning that Catholics have a serious obligation to attend Mass that day. Masses will be celebrated in our Church on Monday, August 14th at 7 PM, and on Tuesday, August 15th at 7 and 8:30 AM and 7 PM.

The Assumption celebrates the Truth that, when her life on earth was complete, our Blessed Mother, Mary, was taken – body and soul – to be with Jesus in Heaven. It is important to note that – unlike Jesus – Mary did not 'ascend' to Heaven. She was 'assumed' – and there is a big difference.

To 'ascend' means to go up to Heaven on your own power – something Jesus could do because He is God. But being human, our Blessed Mother had to be 'assumed' – or taken up to Heaven by the power of God. Either way, it is a glorious and awesome thing to consider!

Celebrating our Blessed Mother's Assumption should remind us that Heaven is our final goal. Because of our sinfulness – we will not be taken 'body and soul' to Heaven at the moment of our death. But the Good News is that the Son of Mary – Jesus Christ – came to earth to save us from our sins so that we can indeed go to Heaven one day. By following Him faithfully and seeking His forgiveness for our sins, we can follow where He and His holy Mother have gone!

Finally, it is good to remember that – although death for us will involve the separation of body and soul – we also believe in 'the Resurrection of the Body.' The Church has always taught that on Judgment Day, the souls of the just will be reunited with their bodies for eternity. Celebrating Mary's Assumption – body and soul to Heaven – should cause us to reflect on the glorious destiny that God has for His faithful people!

Those who want to read more about the Assumption can go to the FORMED.org site on the parish website. They always have great little videos or talks about these marvelous truths of our faith.

Please remember that we will have the Mission Co – op Appeal next weekend, August 19 – 20. Fr. Matthew Munishi will preach at all our Masses. He is a priest of the Diocese of Moshi – Kilminjaro in Tanzania, East Africa. A second collection will be taken at Mass next weekend for the support of this missionary diocese.

The Mission Co – op Appeal is held annually in every parish in the United States. By means of the Mission Co – op, a missionary visits and speaks at our parish here, and a collection is taken to support that mission. Thus, the Mission Co – op connects us to the missionary work of the Church and gives us an opportunity to support that good work. It is one way in which we do our part to fulfill Jesus' final command to: 'Go and teach all nations.'

Finally – remember that I am on vacation in western Nebraska this weekend. I will return home in time for Masses next week – and look forward to meeting our missionary priest and seeing all of you.

In the meantime, please say that Hail Mary for me each day, and know that I will be praying for you during the quiet time on my trip. Let's also pray for the sick and for peace.

Saint of the Week: St. Bernard



St. Bernard entered the
Benedictine abbey of Citeaux
with 7 family members and
about 30 friends following his
lead. After three years he was
made abbot of the new
monastery called Clairvaux,
meaning valley of lights. St.
Bernard became widely known

as a counselor and his word was highly respected and sought after. As time progressed, he was pulled away from the monastery more frequently and led to St. Bernard preaching the Second Crusade throughout Europe. When he died years later, it is said that all of Europe mourned. St. Bernard has many titles including, the man of the 12th century, papal advisor, defender of faith, scripture scholar, eloquent preacher, and doctor of the Church etc. May we look to St. Bernard and always stand up for the faith we believe in.

As of this writing, only 154 students have been registered. Please, if you have a child who will be attending 1st through grade in public school in September, the time to register him or her is now!

The St. John Vianney Religious Education Program is an eight-year program, beginning in grade one and continuing through grade eight. We encourage each child to begin attending classes in first grade and attend each successive year through eighth grade. With that said, we realize that for a variety of reasons, some children may not have attended for one or more years. If you have a child who has missed a year or more, please contact me or our Pastor, Fr. John. We will work with you to ensure your child is offered appropriate religious education.




