## Help Needed to "Start A Heart"

The parish community of St. John Vianney is in need of **3 portable AEDs**. Hopefully with your generosity these devices can be purchased in the very near future. The three portable units would be placed strategically on the St John Vianney property. One device would be located in the **Narthex of the church**, one would be placed in the **rectory**, and the third unit would be given to the **SJV School** to build on their excellent AED Program.

**What is an AED?** An Automatic External Defibrillator "AED" is a portable medical device that can analyze heart rhythm and deliver an electrical shock to restore a normal rhythm during a sudden cardiac arrest.

**Why are they needed?** Hopefully these devices will never be needed but like a fire extinguisher it is available in the event that someone suffers a heart attack. Seconds matter when someone has a heart attack.

**What is the cost?** Each unit costs approximately \$1,700.00. In addition to the cost of the unit some parish members would be trained in CPR and the use of the AED units. The total cost for the program is \$7,500.00.

**How can you help?** You can make a donation by placing a donation in the weekly collection in an envelope marked "Save A Heart" or your donation can be dropped off at the rectory.



## *Pastor's Column: July 5 – July 6, 2025*

I hope everyone has a great Independence Day. It has long been one of my favorite National Holidays. Memories of cook outs, parades, and fireworks come to mind every Fourth of July. It was a day filled with family and community – something we can all use.

With the Fourth of July behind, we plunge into our Parish Carnival this week. It begins Tuesday, July 8 and continues through Saturday, July 12. There will be plenty of games, rides, food, raffles and just plain fun. I hope to see you there. Last year's carnival was a great success. It was good to see so many families working and having a good time together. The weather was hot, but that did not hold back the crowds.

I don't have to tell you that, in addition to being a great time, our carnival raises a great deal of money to support our parish. Every person who buys a raffle ticket, wristband for rides, or food helps to maintain our parish and her mission. We owe each of you a very big thank you.

Speaking of saying thank you, I want to say a special thank you to two teachers who retired from our parish school after many years of service. Mrs. Lori Perona taught students in the middle grades – especially math. Mrs. Frances Mendicino taught the little ones in pre – school. Both gave many wonderful years to the children of our parish – and are owed a great deal of thanks!

Speaking of our parish school, I want to say a few words about it. About 340 students attended our parish school last year. They were educated in all the things elementary and middle school students ordinarily learn, like science, math, history, and language. But they also learned the Gospel.

Indeed, what makes a Catholic School different is that we do not so much 'adopt but adapt the New Jersey Curriculum Content Standards. We infuse the curriculum with our Catholic virtues.' Daily Religion classes are part of this, but that is only part of the process. The students pray daily, attend Mass together at least monthly, and go to Confession regularly. During Lent, they attend the Stations of the Cross on Fridays. In all these ways, our students are educated in an environment that is permeated by the Catholic Faith.

You probably have heard of STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) and its role in public education. But in our Catholic School we are committed to STREAM – adding Religion and the Arts to the educational experience. This is intended to help educate students in a more wholistic way that serves not only the mind, but also the soul.

You can learn more about our school by going to its website or calling the school office (732 – 388 – 1662). Please be sure to pray for me – at least one Hail Mary a day. Let's also pray for peace in our troubled world – and for the sick of our parish. You are all in my prayer each day.


