At monthly Parish Council meetings, an automatic agenda item asked of members is, "What are you hearing, good or bad?" Father Dan and the Parish Council would like to know. Above are the current Parish Council members serving St. Mary of the Lakes. If there is anything you would like Father Dan and the Parish Council to know, please tell a member, and they will bring it up at the next meeting.

#### Using the Sunday Envelope to Track Your Attendance

Our Blessed Lord is one who counted and tracked. How did He know that He was sending 72 disciples (Luke 10)? He counted and tracked them. How did the Good Shepherd know He was leaving 99 sheep behind to track down the one that was lost (Luke 15)? He counted and tracked them. We count because you count.

It is your responsibility to track your weekly attendance at Mass. This will be necessary if you are asked to be a godparent or a confirmation sponsor, as you will be required to present a certificate of eligibility (stating that you are a practicing Catholic who attends Mass weekly) at the church where the sacrament will be celebrated. Being a godparent or confirmation sponsor is an honor that is reserved for those who attend Mass weekly. An accurate record of your active participation can only be maintained either by using envelopes or if 1 see and remember that you are attending Mass on a regular basis (Code of Canon Law, Canon 874,3). Electronic givers are asked to check the box indicating the same on the weekly envelope. With a weekend attendance of over

1,700 persons, it is not reasonable to expect that I will be able to remember your weekly attendance.

#### Gym Teacher

St. Mary of the Lakes Catholic School seeks a part-time gym teacher (physical education). The St. Mary of the Lakes Catholic School gym teacher is responsible for planning and implementing physical education activities for students ranging from PreK to 8th grade. Additionally, he/she monitors students and evaluates their achievement of goals. This teacher emphasizes sports-related skills, games, movement patterns, and general fitness activities, all within an environment that embraces our Catholic identity. He/she maintains records and student information for gym class. They are responsible for communication with all parties relating to the progress of students in the gym class. The gym teacher participates in all faculty and staff engagements, including in-service training. The gym teacher is responsible for planning annual events such as Field Day and other school-wide events. This is a 10-month part-time position (25–28 hours per week). Attendance is required for all scheduled school days and in-service training days.

Job duties include preparing/setting up the gym prior to school and the equipment prior to each class. He/she prepares and implements engaging lesson plans and provides safe learning experiences for all students by explaining the rules and safety guidelines for all gym games.

A teaching certification is required. A minimum of 2–3 years of experience supervising students or children in sports and/or group activities is preferred. Strong oral and written communication skills are needed. The role requirements include being able to physically walk and stand for long periods of time and being able to carry, push, set up, and clean up the required gym equipment. ## **VIRTUS** Online


The Diocese of Trenton requires anyone over 18 who participates in a parish ministry to attend a VIRTUS training session every four years to safeguard children and vulnerable adults. This means every adult who currently volunteers for SML Church, School, or PREP and has not previously attended a VIRTUS session, or who has not taken a refresher course in the past four years, must attend a session as soon as possible.

VIRTUS training sessions are offered at parishes throughout the diocese. Parishioners are permitted to attend training at any parish in the diocese. In June, St. Mary of the Lakes will offer the initial certification class, "Protecting God's Children," on Wednesday, June 7th, at 6:30 p.m. in the Emmaus Center.

Pre-registration is mandatory at <u>virtusonline.org</u> as space is limited.

The parish office is not able to register on your behalf.

The Diocese of Trenton is committed to the initiatives outlined in the U.S. Bishops' Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People in regard to the reporting and investigation of sexual abuse allegations involving minors. The Diocese has in place a Victim's Assistance Coordinator, who is available to obtain support for your needs and help you make a formal complaint of abuse.

The Diocese encourages anyone with an allegation to also report that abuse to their local law enforcement agency. The Diocese reports all allegations received to the appropriate county prosecutor's office.


Each meeting is led by one of the members of the team. The R.C.I.A. process involves time not only for instruction but also growth in the practice of the faith through discussion and prayer.

#### Nineteenth Visit to the Most Holy Sacrament

It is sweet to everyone to be in the company of a dear friend; and shall we not find it sweet, in this valley of tears, to remain in the company of the best friend we have, and Who can do us every kind of good; Who loves us with the most tender affection, and therefore dwells always with us? Behold, in the Most Blessed Sacrament we can converse at pleasure with Jesus, we can open our hearts to Him, we can lay our wants before Him, and we can ask Him for His graces; in a word, in this Sacrament we can treat with the King of Heaven, in all confidence and without restraint. Joseph was only too happy when, as the sacred Scripture tells us, God descended by His grace into his prison to comfort him: She went down with him into the pit, and in bands she left him not. [Wisd. x. 13] But we are yet more highly favored; for we have always with us in this land of miseries our God made Man, Who, by His Real Presence, is with us all the days of our life, and comforts and helps us with the greatest affection and compassion. What a consolation it is to a poor prisoner to have an affectionate friend, who keeps him company, consoles him, gives him hope, succors him, and thinks of relieving him in his misery!

Behold our good friend Jesus Christ, Who in this Sacrament encourages us, saying: Behold, I am with you all days. [Matt. xxviii. 20] Behold Me, He says, all thine: I am come from Heaven into thy prison expressly to console thee, to help thee, to deliver thee. Welcome Me, and do so always; cling to Me and thus thou wilt never feel thy miseries; and afterwards thou wilt come with Me to My kingdom, where I shall make thee perfectly happy.

O God, O incomprehensible ocean of love, since Thy condescension towards us is so great, that in order to dwell near us Thou descendest upon our Altars, I propose often to visit Thee; I am determined, as often as I possibly can, to enjoy Thy most sweet presence, which is the beatitude of the Saints in Heaven. Oh, could I but always remain in Thy presence, to adore Thee and to make Thee acts of love! Arouse, I beseech Thee, my soul, when through tepidity or worldly affairs it neglects to visit Thee. Enkindle in me a great desire always to remain near Thee in this Sacrament. Ah, my loving Jesus, would that I had always loved Thee! would that I had always pleased Thee! I console myself that I still have time to do so, not only in the next life, but also in this. I am determined to do so; I am determined to love Thee indeed, my sovereign good, my love, my treasure, my all. I will love Thee with all my strength.

Ejaculatory prayer. My God, help me to love Thee!

#### Catechism Corner

The Dogma of the Holy Trinity



The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the "consubstantial Trinity". The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that

which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God." In the words of the Fourth Lateran Council (1215), "Each of the persons is that supreme reality, viz., the divine substance, essence or nature."
