- 8th graders should be working towards completing their Confirmation Community Service requirement of 30 hours which was assigned in 6th grade. Hours are due by <u>December 31st, 2023</u>. All 8th graders should be using the Mobile Serve App to track hours. Instructions for creating a Mobile Serve Account can be found on both the school and parish websites. Please note that when entering hours, students should be using the email tnolan@smlparish.org as the Supervisor of service so that notification is sent through our database of hours completed. - Option 1: List the Seven Sacraments and explain what each means. Identify which are considered Sacraments of Initiation and then identify which one Sacrament completes the Initiation into the Catholic Church.
- Option 2: List and explain the Seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit then choose the gift which you feel is most important and meaningful in your life at this point.
