

# Reflection: Witnessing through Love by Nancy Stoll

"Each one of us is called to warm hearts and stir faith by small acts of kindness ..."



It may be as simple as having a kind word to say or knowing the right time to speak (and when to just be present in silence). God is with us always. Sometimes He is right there, "in your face", very hard to miss. But most often, I think, He comes disguised in the everyday-ness of our lives. And so, we have to be attentive or we may miss Him.

It's easy to look back and see where we may have handled some situation differently (better?). And that's ok, we learn from those moments and hopefully grow a little each time.

When we see this happening in our lives, it's a wonderful reminder to ourselves to slow down — or at least try to be a little more present in each moment. Easy to say, but hard to do! But if we can recognize another's need for some attention, it will be impossible to look away without acting. Maybe a pat on the back for some accomplishment or a hug for a defeat?

Simple acts of kindness go such a long way. We each have opportunities to be the face of Jesus for a friend or stranger — will you have such an encounter today?
