



Policies for Cemeteries In General

[Owner: *Cemeteries Administrative Operations Manager*]

25-A The statement of any employee of the Management shall not be binding upon the Management except as such statement coincides with the document conveying the right of interment and these rules and regulations.

25-B These rules and regulations shall apply to any plot, memorial, mausoleum, etc., now in existence or which may hereafter be erected in the Cemetery.

25-C The Management shall in no way be liable for any delay in fulfillment of any of its contractual or legal obligation, including but not limited to maintenance, care, burial of the dead, memorial work or construction, which may arise from causes beyond its reasonable control including delays caused by the elements, an Act of God, common enemy, thieves, vandals, strikes, malicious mischief-makers, explosions, unavoidable accidents, invasions, insurrections, riots, or order of any military or civil authority.

25-D The Management reserves the right, without notice, to make exceptions, suspensions, or modifications in any of these rules or regulations when, in its judgement, the same appear advisable; and such exceptions, suspension, or modifications shall in no way be considered as affecting the general application of such rule.

25-E In all matters not specifically covered by these rules and regulations, the Management reserves the right to do anything which in its judgment is deemed reasonable in the premises, and such determination shall be binding upon the plot owner and all parties concerned.

25-F The Management reserves the right at any time and from time to time to change, amend, alter, repeal, rescind, or add to these rules and regulations or any part thereof or to adopt any new rule of regulation with respect to one or all Cemeteries under its ownership or jurisdiction.

25-G Management is hereby empowered to enforce all Rules and Regulations and to exclude from the property any person violating same. The Cemetery Management has control of all grounds and buildings, and, at all times, shall have supervision and control of all persons in the Cemetery, including conduct of funerals, other services, traffic, employees, title owners/holders and visitors.
