*From Deacon John...*

Today's reading from Genesis is God's call to Abram (Abraham). He instructs him to leave home for a land that God had chosen for him. Abram's response is real stewardship. Instead of clinging to his home and way of life, Abram recognizes God's new gift, puts his trust in Him, and obeys. God rewards him, "I will make your name great, so that you will be a blessing." To "be a blessing" is the aim of a stewardship way of life. It is also an excellent way to live out Lent. The sacrifices we take on, the spiritual disciplines we practice, and the acts of service we perform give glory to God and transform our lives into a blessing for others.

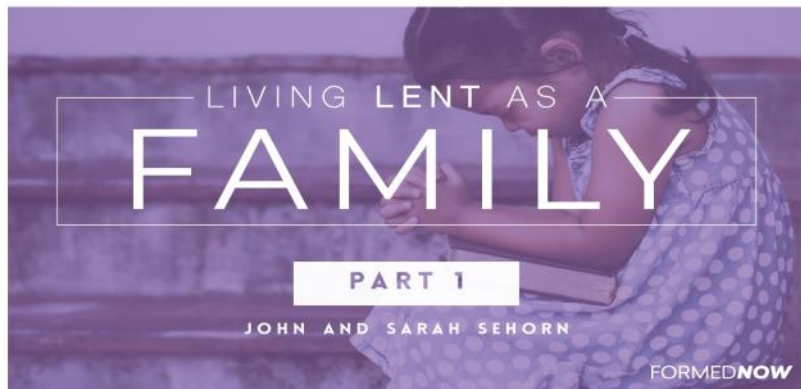

### Background on the Gospel

For the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert to his Transfiguration. Each year on the first Sunday of Lent, our Gospel tells the story of Jesus' temptation in the desert. On the second Sunday of Lent each year, we hear the story of Jesus' Transfiguration.

The story of Jesus' Transfiguration is told in the three Synoptic Gospels: Matthew, Mark, and Luke. In each of those Gospels, the Transfiguration follows Jesus' first prediction of his death and his teaching about the costs of

discipleship. Jesus' Transfiguration is a promise of Jesus' glory, his Resurrection.

On a mountain in today's reading, a voice affirms that Jesus is God's Son in words reminiscent of the voice at Jesus' baptism. In addition, the appearance of Moses and Elijah on the mountain connects this story with God's relationship to the people of Israel. Moses and Elijah represent the Law and the Prophets, respectively. Together with Jesus, they represent God's complete Word.

The Transfiguration occurs in the presence of just three of Jesus' disciples: Peter, James, and John. In Matthew's Gospel, those disciples are among the first whom Jesus calls. The three men are identified as an "inner circle" among Jesus' disciples when Jesus asks them to accompany him to the Garden of Gethsemane just before his arrest.

**Breaking the Silence of Abuse** We are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about it. 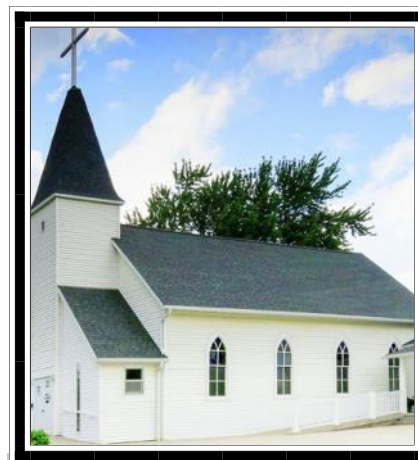
