<u>Administrative Report – Scott Ehlinger</u>

Continue with mitigation strategies. Things are going very well. Any covid numbers are coming from outside of the school. Slight uptick now, like the community. Lunch changes – had four kids at table now just three. Put an extra table in the multipurpose room. On the stage, now just two kids at a table. Trying to ensure the six feet rule at lunch to prevent the spread when masks are off. 75 permanent distance learners. (About 25 students stayed on before Christmas and most have returned.)

Some will return next week at the quarter. We continue with hybrid of classes for distance learners. Instruction is working well. Getting feedback is the challenge. Not seeing a drop off in testing. Monday having a diocesean meeting that includes growth reports. We are looking at if the kids are growing holistically? Catholic Schools Week – January 31st – Meeting with Fr. Chris and Loralee to plan the week. Maybe a half day on that Wednesday, February 3rd for prepackaged lunch for teachers. Start doing tours. Maybe doing an hour block in the morning for tours. Would follow mitigation strategies – take temp, wear mask, stay in the hallway...Much different experience to see the school when people are here. Assessments – MTSS – Diocese is looking at it as a long term program, which would be wonderful. For example, all first grade teachers in the diocese would meet together to be on the same. The kids are wearing masks now at recess. We haven't had to have in door recess yet, thankfully. For lunch, they have a seating chart, so we know who is where and sitting next to each other.

Lisa – Thanked Scott for doing a great job at figuring out how to spread out at lunch. Tours during the school day highlights the great work the school has done with mitigation strategies.

Leenie – Said that her daughter stayed home from Thanksgiving to New Years and had a wonderful experience. Thank you!
