

***Disposal of Blessed Palms***

With Lent quickly approaching, many parishioners have begun to inquire about the appropriate and dignified disposal of blessed palms from last year. Like other articles that have been subject to blessing, palms should not be discarded with ordinary trash. They should also not be left around the church narthex and PLC foyer as clutter for someone else to take care of. Most parishes use pre-prepared ashes on Ash Wednesday, which are burned, ground, and sifted professionally to ensure the proper moisture context (so they don't end up in our eyes and all over our clothes) and a fine enough texture to avoid cuts and scrapes. As such, *the parish has no need for dry palms*. My suggestion is to crumble them up and scatter the pieces in the garden or around houseplants. Perhaps the blessing of Almighty God may succeed at keeping industrious Kitchener-area rabbits and squirrels away from our flower and vegetable beds...nothing else seems to work!




