

RECEIVERS OF BLESSINGS

Today, the liturgy celebrates itself, as it were. It draws our attention to the wondrous gift that is the Eucharistic banquet and whets our appetites both for the banquet we are presently enjoying, and for the Messianic banquet to come. Through our reception of the Eucharist, we become the receivers of many blessings: the blessings



of the covenant with God and with one another, the blessing of Jesus himself becoming flesh of our flesh, the blessing of communion with one another as the body of Christ, the blessing of a future that will be spent in lasting celebration at the heavenly table of the Lord. Today's liturgy draws our attention to all of this. This feast reminds us that our weekly celebration of Eucharist is far more than a simple nostalgic gathering. It is a vital encounter with the blessing and presence of him who is the nourishment and meaning of all our weeks, all our days. Today's celebration reminds us that every Eucharist fulfills God's ancient covenant with the gift and abiding presence – the Body and Blood – of the promised one.


