BIBLE SUNDAY

This weekend marks our 3rd Annual Bible Sunday within our Diocese. In honour of Bible Sunday, the Diocese has shared the following resource with us, to help us in our prayer with and study of Scripture:

What does it say? Determine as closely as possible the literal meaning of the text. *What do the words say? What is the range of meaning in the words?*

What does it mean? The meaning of a text is determined not simply from the words but also from the context in which the words exist.

What does it mean to me? How does this apply to my life? How does this apply to the life of the Church?

What am I going... ...to do about it? What difference does this text mean for my life? What is my response to God's word?

PASTORAL TEAM UPDATE

In the gospel passage from Matthew this weekend, we hear of Jesus' calling of Simon (Peter) and Andrew his brother, as well as James and his brother John. Those first apostles heard Jesus' invitation and followed him. They left the familiarity of their fishing nets and boats and followed the call of the Lord. We might not have the same experience of seeing Jesus standing in front of us along the seashore, asking us to follow him, but we are called. Daily, we are invited by Christ to follow in his footsteps, to seek out those on the margins, to be people of love and mercy. This call can, at times, seem daunting – we don't always "feel like being like Jesus." In fact, we have the ability to choose whether or not we will "be like Jesus." In reality, it's when it's difficult, when we are stretching beyond ourselves and our comfort zones, that we are truly living as Jesus would have us live. Pope Francis writes, "If following Jesus seems difficult, don't be afraid, trust him, be confident that he is close to you, he is with you and he will give you the peace you are looking for and the strength to live as he would have you do."
