FR.TIMUPDATE

It is the policy of the Diocese of Hamilton that each year the pastor of a parish presents a report to his parishioners on the financial status of the parish. I will be making this presentation at all of our Masses this weekend and you will find it included in this week's bulletin our financial statements. You will notice that our parish has reported an operating loss for the last three years. This is due primarily to a decrease in the amount of donations received over the last three years without a corresponding decrease in expenses. We have been able to decrease some expenses in my time so far, through retirement and some austerity in the office, rectory, and ministry expenses. We will continue these measures in the year ahead with the hopes of bringing the projected loss of \$32,034 for this year down to 0. Thank you for your continued financial support of our parish, it is very much appreciated!
