

Father Peter's Corner

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR B

There is always a question of why people suffer. This question gets more harder for people to understand when they see innocent and just people also suffer, and sometimes they get severe suffering beyond explanation. Job was like those just and innocent people. Job laments of his suffering, he compares his suffering to a salve who works in sunny and looks for a shade to cool his body, also he compares the suffering he gets to a hired person who eagerly awaits his wages. Job feels nights are much longer than ever in his life. He felt neglected because of the suffering which had no sign of relief. In spite of all suffering we may face in life the psalmist reminds us:" He (God) heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds". Jesus proves his divine power over physical and spiritual suffering by healing the mother-in-law of Simon. God is compassion to our suffering, he heals us and cares us with love: "Bless the Lord, my soul, do not forget all the gifts of God. Who pardons all your sins, heals all your ills. Delivers your life from the pit, surrounds you with love and compassion ". Psalm 103: 2-4. In time of suffering there is a feeling of being neglected but God has time for everything, he sees, and he knows when to act. Let us always trust the Lord in time of joy and suffering: "I consider that the suffering of this present time is as nothing compared with the glory to be revealed for us." Romans 8: 18. When we refer to the mystery of the suffering of Jesus Christ on the Cross which led to death and resurrection, we get the answer of the meaning of suffering in our lives: "For to you has been granted, for the sake of Christ, not only to believe in him but also to suffer for him". Philippians 1:29.
