

Father Peter's Corner

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR B

Lent is the time of conversion where the mother church invites her children to return to their creator by good deeds and actions to escape from the wrath of God, God is compassionate, kind, and full of mercy. Lent is the time of evaluation and review of our promise we made in Baptism. Lent is the time to rend our hearts and commit to prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Baptism purifies us from the Original Sin as it was prefigured in the time of Noah where God purified the generation of time of Noah by flood and made new covenant with Noah, we are purified and made people of the covenant. After Baptism and confirmation, we are exposed to the temptations and trials of the world. Jesus had been Baptized and before he started his ministry he went to the desert where he was tempted by Satan. As it was to Jesus, we are always tempted by the devil who lingers around us day and night. Because of our spiritual failures Jesus tells us today: "Repent and believe in the Gospel". This message we heard on Ash Wednesday, the minister placing ashes on our foreheads said: "Repent and believe in the Gospel". It is the time to repent and to believe in the gospel. Lent is the time for repentance and conversion: "If then my people, upon whom my name has been pronounced, humble themselves and pray, and seek my face and turn from their evil ways, I will hear them from heaven and pardon their sins and heal their land" 2Chronicles 7:14. Lent is the time to turn from our evil tendencies and turn to God. Repentance is to take time to see in our inner self and say to God; I am a sinner, I have sinned against you: "Let the wicked forsake their way, and sinners their thought; let them turn to the Lord for mercy; to our God, who is generous in forgiving". Isaiah 55:7. In order to have true repentance we are required to be honest of ourselves, strip our hearts and make true contrition to make true spiritual changes.
