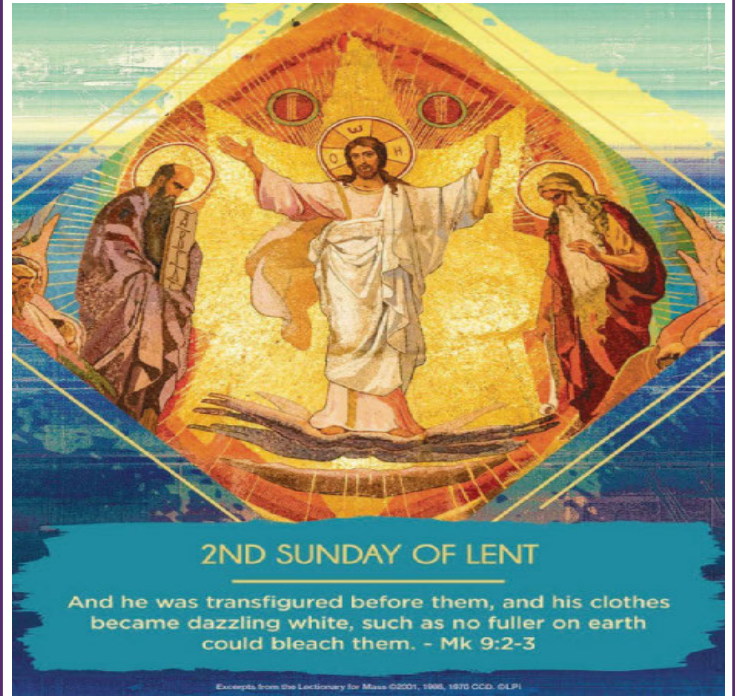

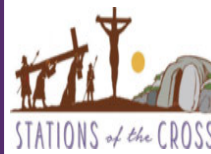

Father Peter's Corner

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR B

"For you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. And let perseverance be perfect, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing". James 1:3-4. Abraham was tested to offer sacrifice his son Isaac, the son of promise who would inherit him. Abraham did not hesitate to offer his son his favorite son. God saw the great faith of Abraham by not withholding his son, because of the great faith of Abraham God made promise to bless Abraham and his descendants. Abraham teaches us of how to persevere in trials and how to face them. God also did not withhold his Son, he offered him as the sacrifice for the salvation of the world. The sacrifice of Isaac prefigured the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus is transfigured on the mountain before his disciples to anticipate the result of his crucifixion, in which he will offer himself as the sacrifice for the salvation of the world. Christian life is a journey which has trials and obstacles, the trials and obstacles are not sign of God's abandonment but they help for spiritual growth: *"Beloved, do not be surprised that a trial by fire is occurring among you, as if something strange were happening to you" 1Peter 4:12.* When we cross these obstacles and the trials we are purified and our faith is strengthened. Jesus' passion, death and resurrection has given us salvation and has shown us the way to salvation. God can bring something good out of evil; the passion death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ we have been saved and seen the glory of God.

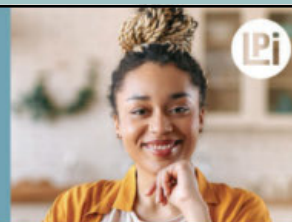
