

FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR B

The people of Judah and their religious leaders had lost faith to the Lord their God, which led to the destruction of the Temple by the Babylonians. After long persistence in sin even after God had sent them messengers they did not heed to the warnings and change their life. Therefore, their enemies burnt the house of God and destroyed the city of Jerusalem and took people to exile in Babylon. God inspired king Cyrus, the king of Persia who delivered the Israelites from Babylon and let them go back to Jerusalem to rebuild the Temple of the Lord. God is gracious and full of mercy he does not deal with us according to our iniquities: "Merciful and gracious is the Lord, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. He will not always accuse, and nurses no lasting anger; He has not dealt with us as our sins merit nor requite us as our wrongs deserve". Psalm 103:8-10. God's mercy, love and compassion to human beings is displayed on the Cross. Jesus' passion and death on the Cross is the sign of love of God to us: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends". John 15:13. Jesus' conversation with Nicodemus on the uplifted serpent made by Moses in the desert for the healing to the Israelites bitten by snake in the desert was foreshadowing of his passion which he would endure by being uplifted on the Cross for the healing of sins of the world. Jesus paid our debt to his Father by his passion and death and won victory against death by his resurrection: "But God proves his love for us in that while we were still sinners Christ died for us". Romans 5:8. As God saved the Israelites from slavery in Babylon which they did not deserve because of his love and mercy, Jesus did the same to us, although we were not worthy, we were saved by his passion, death, and resurrection. Let us use this Lenten Season to renew our faith and to look intently at Jesus on the Cross and ask for the healing of our spiritual wounds.
