

Father Peter's Corner

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT YEAR B

God promised to make another covenant with the house of Israel after the previous covenants. The new covenant which the Lord wanted to make he would write the Law in their hearts. He promised to forgive all evil doings. God promised not to count and remember their sins anymore. Our God is the God of mercy and love, who does not count our sins, is ready to forgive our wrong doings. This message of the Lord who forgives gives us hope. The covenant which God made with his people created new page of relationship between God and his people. This covenant makes us confident of our relationship with Jesus and that amid suffering we will not perish. Jesus' analogy of the grain of wheat refers of his own passion, death, and resurrection; that unless the grain of wheat falls on the ground and dies will remain a single grain, the passion and death and resurrection of Jesus will bear fruits, which is the salvation of all humankind. Again, Jesus reminds us that following him is not an easy task, requires sacrifice.
