

Father Peter's Corner

PALM SUNDAY YEAR B

The Palm Sunday's reflection focuses on the obedience and suffering of our Lord Jesus Christ which was foreshowed by prophet Isaiah. The message of prophet Isaiah which was spoken hundreds of years before Jesus Christ came has been fulfillment in the Gospel by the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Prophet Isaiah prophecy on the suffering servant who was humiliated but did not react is fulfilled in Jesus Christ who though suffered and humiliated he put trust to his Father. Though Jesus was God like the Father was obedient to his Father and accepted death on the Cross for the salvation of the world. Jesus fulfilled his mission by passion and death on the Cross, while on the Cross Jesus felt abandonment by God: "My God, My God why have you abandoned me?". The abandonment feeling of Jesus during suffering on the Cross is the same feelings we experience most of us in the time of suffering and hard times; we feel abandonment by God. God is always with us; we need to be more courageous and faithful in hard times knowing that God is closer to us in the time of suffering. The crucifixion of Jesus stirs up the feelings of God's love to us. God's presence is evident in the darkest moments of our life. The darkest moments of our lives God is with us, He gives us strength and courage as he did to His Son our Lord Jesus Christ when he was on the Cross.
