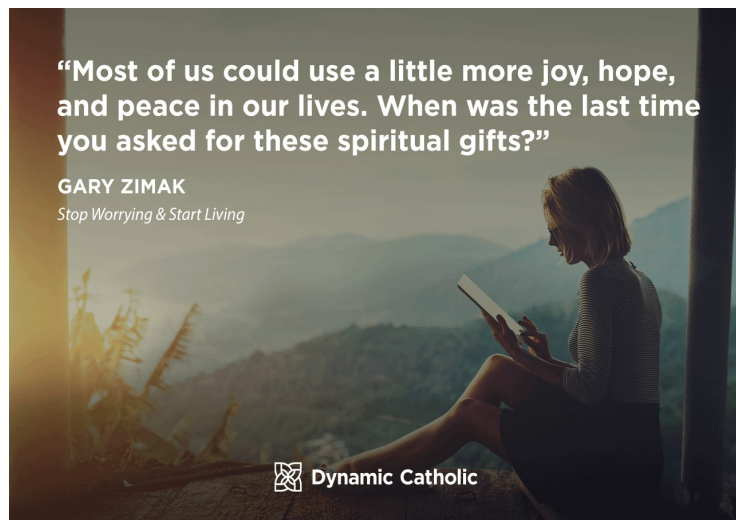
### **SEWING/CRAFT DAY:**
