Fr. Vittorio Boria, OFM Cap will be at our Mass today Sunday, August 20th. The Capuchin Franciscans are essentially a Missionary Order. (Their founder St. Francis of Assisi tried to go Missionary in Egypt where he met with the Saladin of Muslim army, St. Anthony of Padua passed to the Franciscan hoping he would go to the Saracene, the Capuchin St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen is the patron saint of the Papal Congregation Propagation of the Faith, tasked with the promotion of the Missions.) Fr. Vittorio will present the missionary work of the capuchins in the war-torn Sudan in East Africa and specifically for Saint Gabriel the Archangel Catholic Church today. A Capuchin missionary has chosen to stay with the poor, the sick, the elderly, the disabled and the dying while others are fleeing from Sudan. Over 2 million have been displaced.
