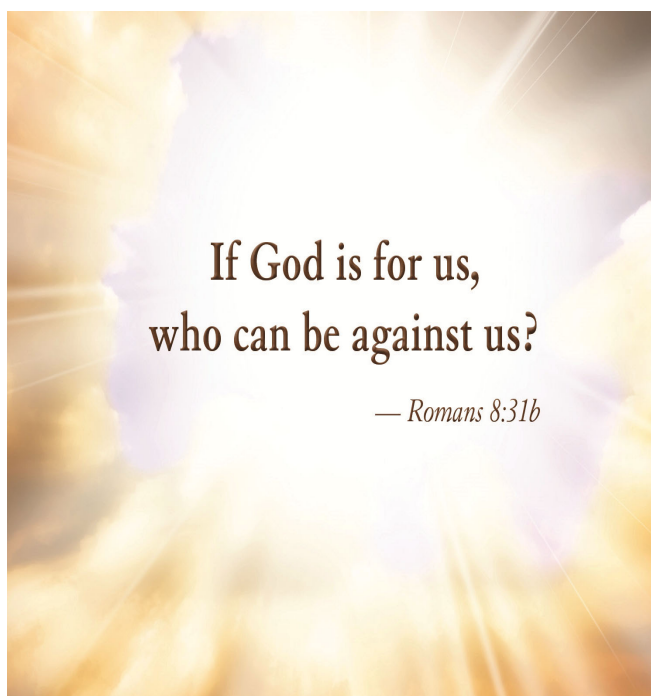

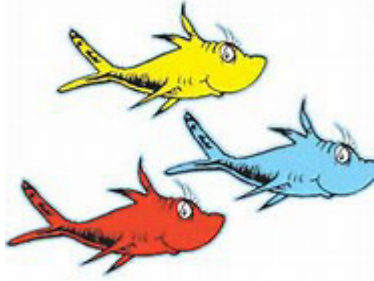

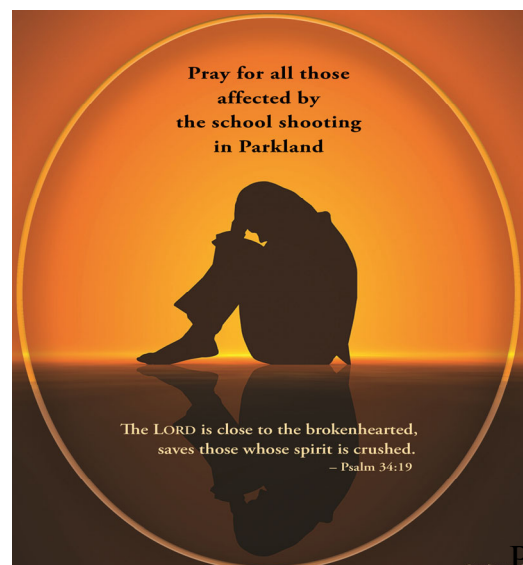

A few church items:

- . The Stations of the Cross have not yet been placed in the Church, we are still having Friday evening Stations, though. Hopefully they will be in their designated space very soon.
- . Holy Water fonts will be placed soon, but we still have holy water available at the doorway to the church.
- . We hope to resume offering the Sacrament of the Blood of Christ at Holy Communion in the near future.
- . In a week or so we are expecting the handicapped access to the church itself and to the Rest Rooms in the narthex to be available.
