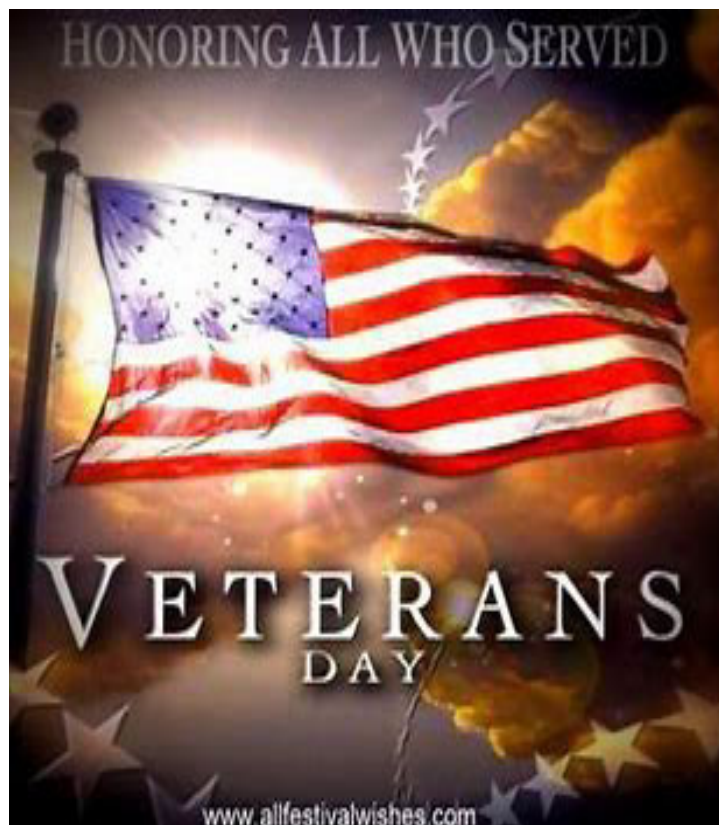

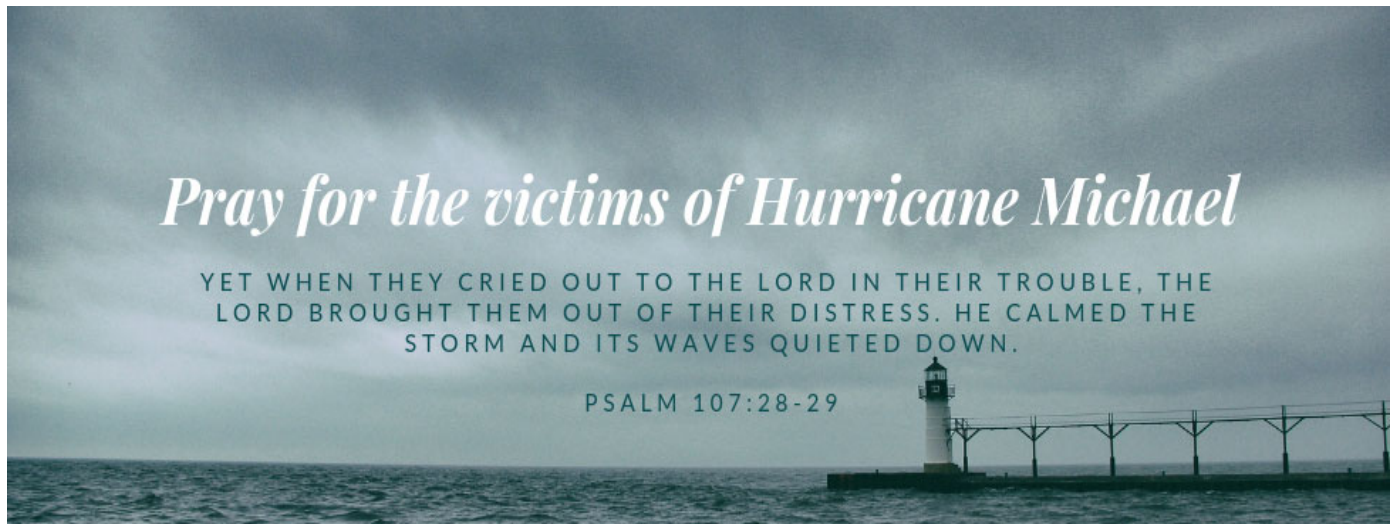
A Big Shout Out To Father Chris!

Dear friends, as we have been sharing with you about our visit to Bihawana, Dodoma, it has become clear that it would be better to have at least one evening where we could share our stories and faith journey. Such an idea made us think about the different events which have already happened, and it was amazing when we realized that the most noteworthy word was 'celebration'.

We remembered our first experience of celebrating with children after Mass (refer to prior article), and many other events - celebrating with family, at a convent, in the countryside.

The second phrase was 'the face of Christ'. We could see the face of Christ in our brothers and sisters in Dodoma, seminarians in their struggle to become good and holy priests, children learning about their faith without books, parents nurturing the love of learning in their children. At the same time, that is also what they saw in us, people from Nativity.

So we thought it would be great to call our evening "Nativity with Bihawana Celebrates the Face of Christ". It is our hope that during the evening we will be able to share videos of children dancing and praising God, photos of families farming together, nuns encouraging carpentry students, and priests at chapels in the bush - life in Tanzania.
